Could you please make a notation on that Form 40 as to why there was a repeated AF/MA then initial and date it and send me a copy?
- 4. While these two inspections technically satisfy the inspections for July and August, I suggest (in the interest of smooth court proceedings) that you still do a normal monthly inspection closer to your usual date. (Maybe before midnight the night it would be "due".) *smiles
