Ref to instrument 80-000966, The Alcohol Free Subject Test: showed a 0.009, due to residual mouth alcohol from the previous Mouth Alcohol test. The test was completed and noted as not within standards. The instrument was re-tested and the results are with in standards.

Ref to instrument 80-000968, AF/MA initial reading of SNM for AF. Re-tested, Had another Deputy provide AF. The re-test results are with in standards

Ref to instrument 80-003937, 0.05g/210L Test, re-set lid to simulator, re-tested. 0.20g/210L Test, re-set lid to simulator. The re-test results are with in standards. The inspection was not Re-Started.
