Hello,

It appears that instruments 836 and 1238 were inspected last month using expired 0.20 Alcohol Reference Solution. The inspection records will need to be amended to show an expired solution was used and the instruments were not compliant with Chapter 11D-8, FAC. Once you've made the amendments, please email them to me so I can update our records.

Please discard any remaining expired solution, pull both instruments from evidential use, and perform the June inspection on them as soon as possible. Once the data has been uploaded, I can send you a list of the affected breath tests for you to forward to your local State Attorney's Office. If they have any questions, they can contact me to discuss.

If possible, I would recommend performing future Agency Inspections in the first half of the month rather than the last day. That way, there is time to repeat the monthly inspection if needed.

After reviewing the amended document, it looks like an expired 0.08 solution was used during the July inspection of 80-001238. Please add another comment to the Form 40 indicating that expired solution was used and amend the paperwork to indicate that it is noncompliant with 11D-8. (Your other instruments did not have July inspections but appear to have been kept out of evidential use for the month, since there are no July breath tests on them). Once you have added the remark and updated the compliance, please scan the Form 40 back to me so I can add it to the website.

I've attached a list of all the affected breath tests. Please distribute to your local State Attorney's Office and let them know these tests were run on an instrument that didn't have a compliant inspection for the month. If they have any questions, please provide them with my contact info so they can reach out to me.
