Hello,

I noticed during my routine data review that you weren't able to obtain a passing Agency Inspection for June due to an unknown source of RFI that occurred during your initial inspection and also the follow-up inspection. If you need assistance identifying the source, please give me a call to discuss further.

Whenever a test within the Agency Inspection is repeated, you should always include a remark about the corrective action you took prior to repeating the test (aka "identified potential source of RFI and removed it"). If you aren't able to get an instrument to pass its monthly inspection, you should contact me per the procedure. This way, I can help troubleshoot, confirm if the instrument should be kept out of evidential use, and direct you to send the instrument to FDLE or a repair facility as needed. Ending the month with a failed inspection can jeopardize any breath tests on the instrument (this is just an FYI, since it appears there were no tests run on it last month).

Since the instrument failed its June inspection, it should already be out of evidential use and it should stay out of evidential use until you can get a passing inspection. If you can't get the instrument to pass its next inspection, please give me a call. Ideally, this is immediately afterward while you still have the alcohol reference solutions and simulators on hand.
