### **December 2007-Orange County**

An AMBER Alert was issued for a 17 year-old-child who text messaged her mother with claims of being held in a house in an unknown location by two males. A patrol officer recognized the vehicle that was listed in the AMBER Alert. Charges were filed for making a false report. The arrest of the person making the false report will hopefully be a deterrent to others.

## **Success Story**

### **October 2007-Polk County**

An AMBER Alert was issued for a 15 year old, who was lured from her home by a registered sexual offender via the internet. It is believed that the suspect heard or saw the AMBER Alert and released the child at a department store located in the Panhandle.

## **Success Story**

### **June 2007-Duval County**

An AMBER Alert was issued for two children 14 and 15 years old, who were violently forced into a vehicle, along with an adult female, by the non-custodial father after physical confrontation. The AMBER Alert notification was sent to law enforcement and shortly after, the suspect was apprehended and the children were later rescued.
