January 2012 – Palm Beach County

An AMBER Alert was issued for a 2-week old infant who was allegedly abducted by a woman the mother had met on a social networking site. Information gained from investigative efforts led law enforcement to be able to identify the woman and distribute her name and photograph as part of the AMBER Alert. After seeing the report on television, a citizen called in with information on the whereabouts of the suspect. The child was recovered safely.

Success Story

October 2012 - Miami-Dade County

An AMBER Alert was issued for a 1-year-old male who was allegedly abducted along with his mother by his non-custodial father. The father had a history of violence and an outstanding felony warrant. An FHP trooper identified the vehicle as part of the AMBER Alert. The child and mother were recovered safely.
