Deputy Director Charles "Chuck" Murphy, Department of Law Enforcement – Division of Criminal Justice Information Services



FDLE Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division Deputy Director (DD) Charles Murphy oversees the Crime Information Bureau (CIB), the Firearm Eligibility Bureau (FEB), and the Criminal History Services (CHS) Unit. CIB maintains Florida's criminal history repository and Biometric Identification Solution and is responsible for processing applications for certificates of eligibility for determining if an individual qualifies to have his/her criminal record sealed or expunged. FEB is responsible for handling all requests from Federal Firearm Licensees to conduct demographic-based record checks on all potential firearm transfers to determine if the transferee should be prohibited from taking possession of the firearm. FEB also maintains Florida's Mental Competency

Database. CHS is responsible for processing state and national criminal history records checks for individuals seeking employment or licensure as authorized by state statute. This unit is also responsible for administering the Volunteer and Employee Criminal History System (VECHS) created under the authority of the National Child Protection Act.

Prior to his current assignment, DD Murphy served in a variety of roles including Chief over FEB, the Planning and Policy Administrator over Field Services (Compliance and Training), and the Supervisor over the Compliance Unit of CJIS. He has over 20 years of service to FDLE – all within the CJIS Division.

DD Murphy represents the state of Florida at the national level as a member of the FBI National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) Sub Committee where he, other state representatives, and the FBI discuss and develop firearm policies. Additionally, he is the Chair of the FBI National Crime Information Center (NCIC) Third Generation (N3G) Task Force, where he works with other state representatives and the FBI to develop policies and system enhancements for the next generation of the NCIC, and he is a member of the National Rap Sheet Standardization Task Force, which was established to help develop a national standard for criminal history rapsheets.

DD Murphy holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in business administration from Flagler College, and he is a 2013 graduate of the FDLE Advanced Leadership Program.
