

Gina Giacomo, Director of Administration, Florida Commission on Offender Review



Ms. Gina Giacomo has close to thirty years of criminal justice experience, most of which have been in leadership positions. She started her career at the Department of Corrections as a Correctional Probation Officer supervising offenders in the community, and then as a Classification Officer within the prison system. She began working for the Florida Parole Commission in 1993 and has held positions of Parole Examiner holding violation hearings, determining eligibility of supervision, and conducting Clemency investigations for the Governor and cabinet; Revocations Administrator responsible for issuance of warrants, revocation of offenders, extraditions, interstate compact; and Director of Operations where she was responsible for the program areas of Release Services, Revocations Services, Field Services, and Victim Services statewide.

In December 2008, Ms. Giacomo was appointed the Commission's Director of Administration. In this capacity, she oversees the budget, human resources, information technology, research and data, purchasing, leases, and contracts. During her career, Ms. Giacomo coordinated State and county agencies in a statewide "Warrant Sweep" Task Force, resulting in over 500 offenders being apprehended, and was selected as the lead person for implementing Governor Christ's special initiative on Restoration of Civil Rights. Ms. Giacomo holds an Associate of Science Degree in Criminal Justice; a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Criminal Justice Administration; and a Master of Science Degree in Adult Education.
