Request for Variance or Waiver: Request for a Waiver of Rule 11B-27.002(4), F.A.C., by Shanniott Humphery.

ISSUE

This agenda item is presented to the Commission by Shanniott Humphery to request a waiver of Rule 11B-27.002(4)(a), F.A.C.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- Petitioner is seeking a waiver of Rule 11B-27.002(4) and wishes to waive that portion of the rule that states: (a) Within four years of the beginning date of a Commission-approved Basic Recruit Training Program, an individual shall successfully complete the program, achieve a passing score on the applicable State Officer Certification Examination, and gain employment, and certification as an officer. Petitioner requests a waiver of the rule for ninety (90) days from the date of the Commission approval of this request.
- 2. Petitioner began correctional cross over training for her law enforcement certification on February 2, 2021, and completed the course on March 20, 2023. She passed the requisite State Officer Certification Examination on November 12, 2024.
- **3.** Petitioner cites physical injuries in separate incidents, to include a work-related injury in November 2022 and a car accident in December 2024, as causing her delays in the completion of applications to Florida law enforcement agencies.
- **4.** Petitioner has not previously requested a similar waiver.
- **5.** Petitioner is also currently certified as a correctional officer with the Florida Department of Corrections. Petitioner obtained her correctional certification in 2015.

RECOMMENDATION(S): Commission staff recommends that the Commission DENY the petition for a waiver of Rule 11B-27.002(4)(a).

VOTING IMPACT

CONSEQUENCES OF A "YES" VOTE ON STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Ms. Humphery's request for a waiver of Rule 11B-27.002(4)(a), F.A.C. shall not be granted and she will not be eligible to become a certified law enforcement officer.

CONSEQUENCES OF A "NO" VOTE ON STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Ms. Humphery's request for a waiver of Rule 11B-27.002(4)(a), F.A.C., shall be granted and she shall have 90 days from the date of the Commission's vote to gain employment and certification as a law enforcement officer.

(4)(a) Within four years of the beginning date of a Commission-approved Basic Recruit Training Program, an individual shall successfully complete the program, achieve a passing score on the applicable State Officer Certification Examination, and gain employment, and certification as an officer.

Section 120.542, F.S., Variances and Waivers, mandates threshold proofs and notice provisions for variances and waivers from agency rules. Subsection (2) of this statute states:

Variances and waivers shall be granted when the person subject to the rule demonstrates that the purpose of the underlying statute will be or has been achieved by other means by the person and when application of a rule would create a substantial hardship or would violate principles of fairness. For purposes of this section, "substantial hardship" means a demonstrated economic, technological, legal, or other type of hardship to the person requesting the variance or waiver. For purposes of this section, "principles of fairness" are violated when the literal application of a rule affects a particular person in a manner significantly different from the way it affects other similarly situated persons who are subject to the rule.

PETITION FOR WAIVER OR VARIANCER OF

FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE RULE 11B-27.002 (4)

OFFICE OF THE GENERAL COUNSEL:

I, Shanniott Humphery petitioner, a graduate of North Florida College Public Safety Academy do respectfully request from the Commission a permanent waiver or variance of Rule 11B-27.002 (4); Certification, Employment or Appointment, Reactivation, and Terminating Employment of Officers, specific the rule states: .(4)(a) Within four years of the beginning date of a Commission- approved basic Recruit Training program an individual shall successfully complete the program, achieve a passing score on the applicable state officer Certification Examination, and gain employment, and certification as an officer.

The petitioner completed this course on February 2021 at The North Florida College, but did not gain employment before the expiration date of February 2, 2025.

- 1. The petitioner is a Florida Citizen, Shanniott Humphery, who is now being considered for employment with the Leon County Sheriff's Department as a Reserve Duty Officer.
- 2. I achieved a passing score on the State Officer Certification Examination on November 12, 2024.
- 3. Due to a work-related injury in November 2022, I a ruptured my ACL and meniscus, which required extensive surgery with post recovery time of 1 year including rehabilitation. I also encountered a recent car accident in December 2024, in which I sustained traumatic injuries and totaled loss my car. Due to these incidents, it has delayed my completions of applications to any Florida law enforcement agencies.

- 4. The Petitioner believes she brings great morale, integrity, good ethical standards, and philomath while for seeking new knowledge and experiences with this agency. The petitioner also believes that she would be a great candidate if waiver is granted, and she is subsequently employed.
- 5. Severe economic hardship will be created for Shanniott Humphery if the rule waiver is not granted due to a loss of certification and a loss of income to restart the academy with her own initiative and expense. Shanniott Humphery would not be able to go through another training process and would instead have to attend an ENTIRE Basic Recruit Class again. This will affect her ability to begin work at The Leon County Sheriff Department. Leon County Sheriff Department initiated a PAT test for employment for Shanniott Humphery, however, her certification expires prior to the test.
- 6. The petitioner requests ninety days (90) from the date the Commission votes on this issue to complete the employment process and become a fully Certified Law Enforcement Officer with a local law enforcement agency.
- 7. I respectfully request from the Commission a permanent waiver or variance of Rule 11B-27.002(4), and to be allowed to be appointed by Leon County Sheriff Department to a position as a certified law enforcement officer within 30 days of this petition being heard. Approval of the requested waiver would serve the purpose of the statute the rule as implementing in FS120.54(5)(b).

Petitioner is seeking a waiver of Rule 11B-27.002(4) and wishes to waive that portion of the rule that states: (a) Within four years of the beginning date of a Commission-approved Basic Recruit Training Program, an individual shall successfully complete the program, achieve a passing score on the applicable State Officer Certification Examination, and gain employment, and certification as an officer. Petitioner requests a waiver of the rule for ninety (90) days from the date of the Commission's vote.
