**SUBJECT: Revised Notice of Legal Rights and Remedies Brochure**

Section 741.29, F.S., provides that any law enforcement officer who investigates an alleged incident of domestic violence shall give to the victim immediate notice of legal rights and remedies available on a standard form developed and distributed by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE).

The Notice of Legal Rights and Remedies for Victims of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Repeat Violence, Sexual Violence brochure was recently revised to comply with new legislative mandates from HB 1099 that updates Section 784.048, F.S.

The revised brochure, now titled "Notice of Legal Rights and Remedies for Victims of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Repeat Violence, Sexual Violence, Stalking," is available in English and Spanish to download from the FDLE website at <http://www.fdle.state.fl.us/Content/home.aspx>, through two links:

The revised brochure is effective October 1, 2012. All law enforcement agencies should update their Notice of Rights and Remedies for Victims brochure, pursuant to Section 741.29, F.S.
