SUBJECT: Public Safety Telecommunications Training for Law Enforcement Officers

On May 10, 2012, the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission approved a 40-hour Public Safety Telecommunications for Law Enforcement Officers Specialized Course #1195. This course is approved by the Department of Health for completion by law enforcement officers who fail the Public Safety Telecommunications examination. This course may be delivered at a local agency or training school, but must be taught by a public safety telecommunicator who has been certified through the Department of Health. In addition, Rule 11B-27.00212(9), F.A.C. requires that documentation supporting this training be attached to the Mandatory Retraining Report Form CJSTC-74 and be maintained in the officer's file. Documentation may include an outline of topics of instruction, name(s) of instructor(s), date training was completed, and number of hours completed.

Upon completion of this course, the officer is required to submit a certificate established by the Department of Health as proof of completion when applying to retake the PST examination. On November 8, 2012, FDLE disseminated a certificate that did not specify a signature for Commission-certified training school directors. A revised certificate to include the director's signature is attached and should be used in lieu of the certificate previously disseminated.
