Warning signs shall be posted at all vehicle access points that clearly identify the area as a "vehicle operations training driving range" with access restricted to basic recruit trainees, criminal justice instructors, and personnel authorized by the training center director.					
8	For delivery of night driving exercises driving range equipment shall include:						
	 a. Reflective vests to be worn by all personnel and students; and b. At least one traffic wand for each instructor and other individuals designated to assist in the facilitation of night driving, for example: road guards and traffic control personnel who setup driving cones.
