Examination Admission Vouchers SUBJECT:

Due to the anticipated implementation of Computer Based Testing (CBT) by January 2012, changes were made to Rules 11B-30.008 and 11B-35.001(16), F.A.C., regarding the use of Examination Admission Vouchers, form CJSTC-517, at examination sites. registration will be dependent upon each examinee's training through the Automated Training Management System (ATMS), verification of training via voucher will not be needed; hence, the removal of that wording from rule. The voucher will also be removed as a Commission form.

The changes to Rules 11B-30.008 and 11B-35.001(16), F.A.C., became effective May 21, 2012. However, since CBT has yet to be implemented, the use of examination vouchers is still required. Therefore, please continue to issue the voucher to all qualifying examinees. The voucher will continue to be available through ATMS. Examinees taking the SOCE for the first time will not be allowed into the examination without a completed voucher.
