**Textbook Publishing Contract** 

The FDLE Criminal Justice Professionalism Division produces three basic recruit textbooks annually. The Division's goal is to ensure that training academies have timely access to high quality, low cost textbooks. In the past, FDLE has worked with two vendors to produce the textbooks: one firm for layout and graphic design, the other for production, sales, and delivery. These two contracts ended with the 2018 textbook cycle.

Working closely with FDLE's Office of General Services and Office of General Counsel, staff issued an Invitation to Bid (ITB). The ITB requested a single vendor to provide the following services and roll all costs into textbook prices:

- layout text and graphics
- proof content
- print and bind
- obtain ISBNs

- process orders
- ship orders
- provide eBook version of each textbook
- provide interactive eBook reader

Three vendors responded. The contract was awarded to XanEdu Publishing. XanEdu's prices below may be used for budget estimates; however, the actual textbook prices will be available in February 2019.
