Course #1405, Advanced Defensive Tactics

On October 31, 2019, the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (CJSTC) approved a new course, Advanced Defensive Tactics, #1405. This 40-hour course is part of the Advanced Training Program. It expands on the techniques that are taught in the basic recruit curriculum by providing more advanced-level techniques officers can use when restraining or arresting a person. The course also uses both provided real-world scenarios and instructor-developed scenarios to further develop an officer's ability to assess threats and apply appropriate defensive tactics techniques.
