Course #802, CMS Defensive Tactics Instructor

A new CMS Criminal Justice Defensive Tactics (DT) Basic Recruit Training (BRT) program will go into effect July 1, 2020. As a result, the CMS Defensive Tactics Instructor, course #802, was rewritten to reflect the new techniques that will be part of the BRT DT program. This course is intended for instructors who want to become DT-certified. The 80-hour course requires a demonstration of proficiencies and a written end-of-course examination.

After July 1, 2020, only CJSTC-certified DT instructors who have completed either the Specialized Defensive Tactics Instructor Update course (#1200) or version 2019.10 of the Defensive Tactics Instructor course (#802) will be authorized to teach BRT DT. Instructors who complete their DT certification using the 2019.10 version of course #802 <u>are</u> authorized to teach the 2019 version of BRT DT.
