On May 6, 2021, the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission approved a new course, De-escalation Techniques for Criminal Justice Professionals, number 1411. This 16-hour course is part of the Specialized Training Program. It discusses the definitions and goals of de-escalation in relation to use of force, decision-making, and crisis intervention. It also describes practical techniques and skills used to de-escalate a situation. Finally, this course provides real-world scenarios to allow students to practice the skills and techniques they have learned.
