SUBJECT: Domestic Intervention and Investigation, Course Number 091 (Rewrite)

In 1986, Domestic Intervention, course 091, was developed in support of career development training. In 2021, the course was updated to give officers a broader understanding of the short-term and long-term effects of domestic violence on victims, their families, and communities. At the August 2021 meeting, the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission approved the rewrite of advanced course, Domestic Intervention and Investigation, number 091, effective August 19, 2021.

Domestic Intervention and Investigation is an 80-hour course that takes a culturally-responsive and trauma-informed approach to domestic violence. It outlines task-oriented procedures for investigating cases effectively while highlighting the officer's role in promoting victim safety. Emphasis is placed on gathering sufficient information that will stand independent from victim testimony.
