The department is under a federal injunction to keep the registered Internet identifiers and email addresses of these individuals confidential, except to law enforcement. A public records exemption is necessary to address ruling.
- Section 943.0435(2)(b)3 On-line reporting of vehicle information changes for registrants.
- Section 943.0435(11) Out of state confidential registrants who do not otherwise qualify for Florida registration.
