Rule 11B-21.005, F.A.C., requires that a Commission-certified training school conducting CJSTC first aid training have the following equipment available:

2. \_\_\_\_\_ For every two students actively and physically engaged in first aid practical exercises and testing, the training school shall provide 64 square feet of unobstructed floor space. For each additional student actively and physically engaged, add an additional 32 square feet. Victims are not considered when calculating the total square footage requirements.

3. \_\_\_\_\_ Areas where first aid is used for practical exercises shall be equipped with a first aid kit. The first aid kit shall be at the facility when basic recruit students are actively engaged in practical exercises, and shall be immediately accessible to instructors and basic recruit students.

The first aid kit shall include at a minimum the following supplies:

4. \_\_\_\_\_ For instruction of the CMS First Aid for Criminal Justice Officers Course or CMS First Aid Instructor Course, at least one Commission-certified CMS First Aid Instructor shall be required for every ten students actively engaged in the practical and performance areas of the training. Actively engaged is defined as "a student involved in the practical performance of any first aid skills training."
