

Firearm Involved Violent Crimes

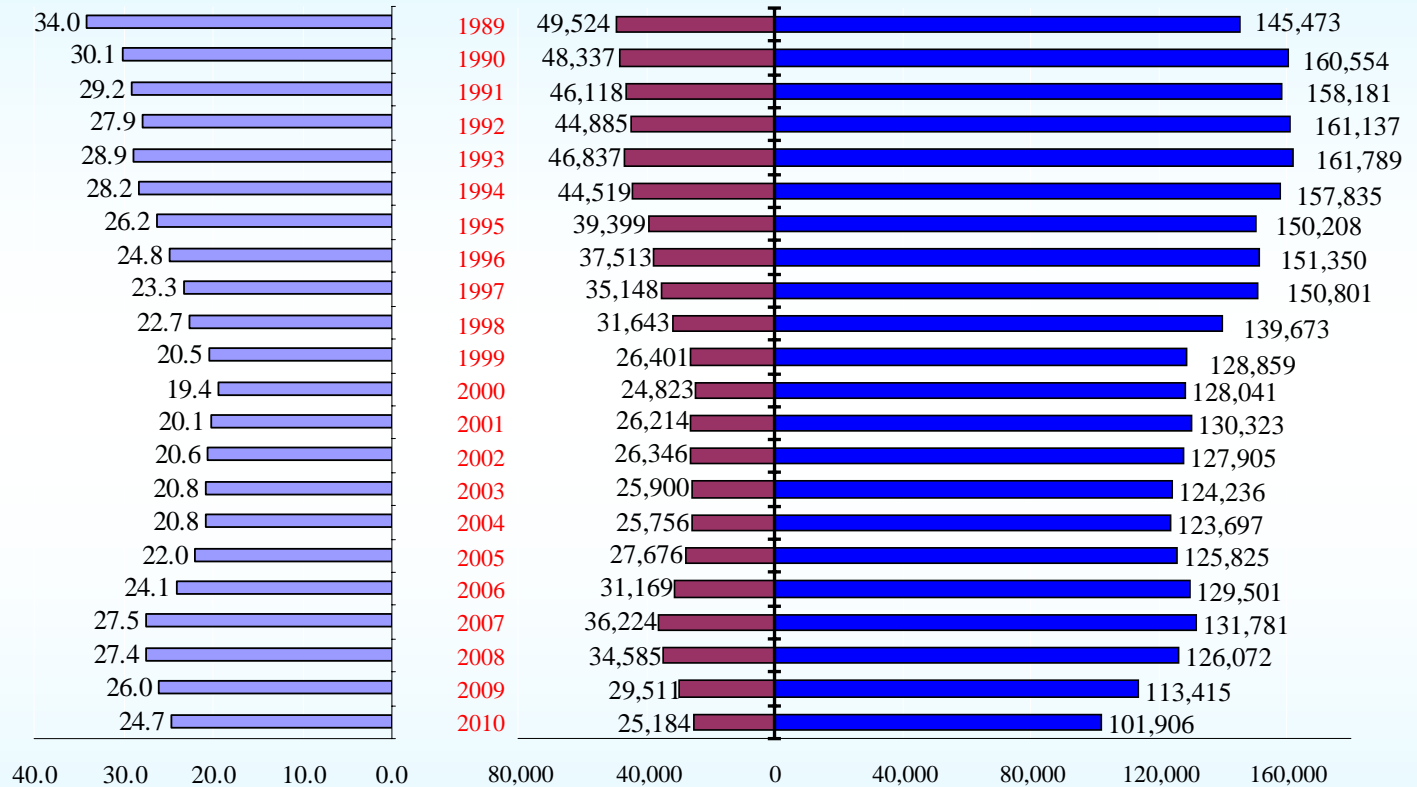
In 2010, a total of 25,184 Violent Index offenses involving a firearm were reported in Florida. Almost 74 percent of those crimes occurred in ten counties (Broward, Miami-Dade, Duval, Escambia, Hillsborough, Lee, Leon, Orange, Palm Beach, and Pinellas). These ten counties hold 58 percent of Florida's population.

Special emphasis continues to be placed on the identification, apprehension, prosecution, and imprisonment of those criminals who use firearms in the course of their illegal activities.

This presentation highlights the distribution of firearm related violent offenses in the State.



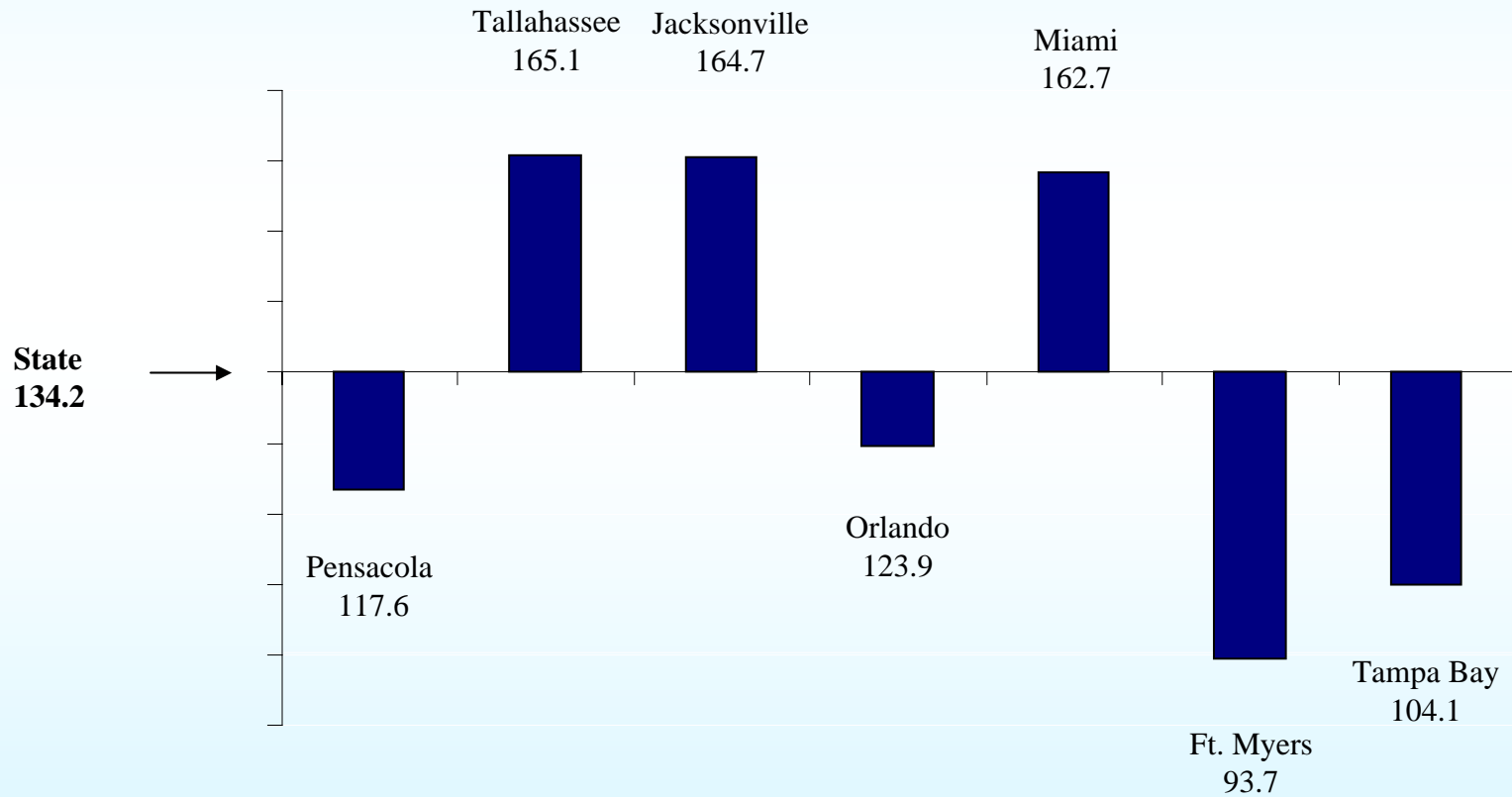
Florida Violent Offenses and Firearm Involved Violent Offenses 1989 - 2010

 Total Violent Offenses



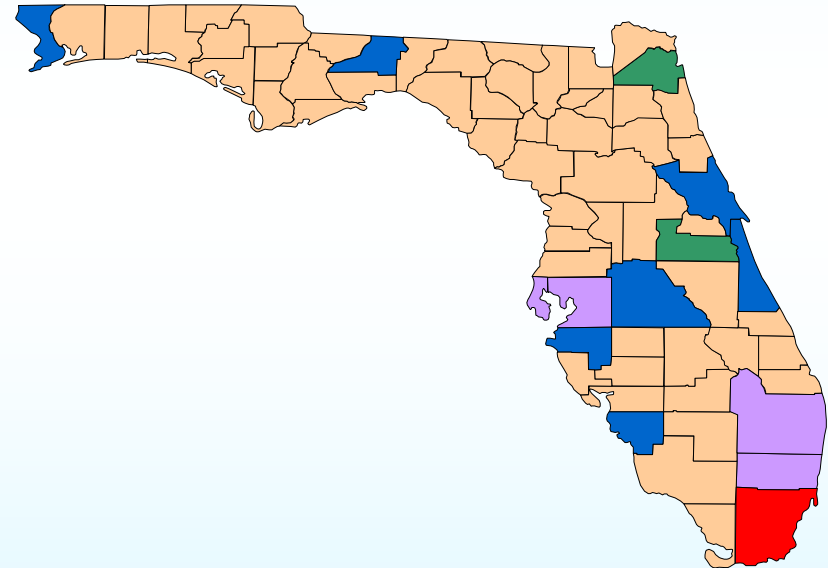
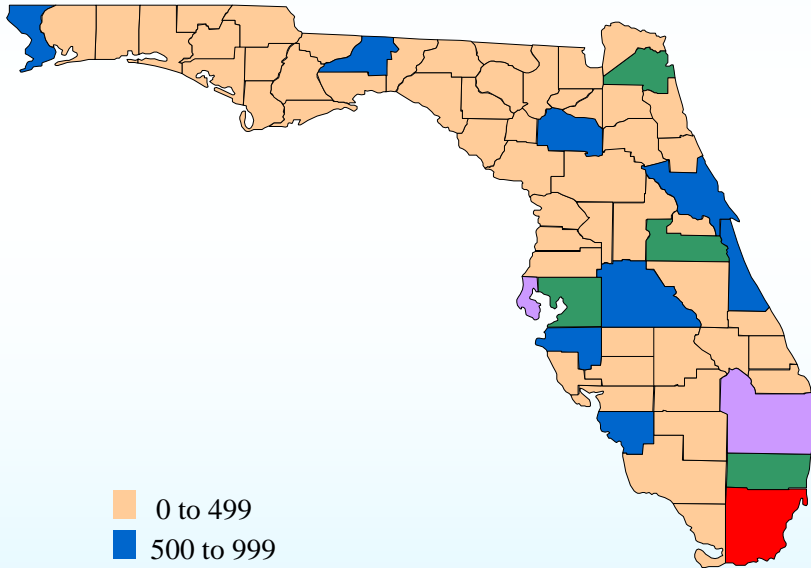
Comparison of Firearm Involved Violent Crime for State and FDLE Regions by Rate per 100,000 Population, 2010

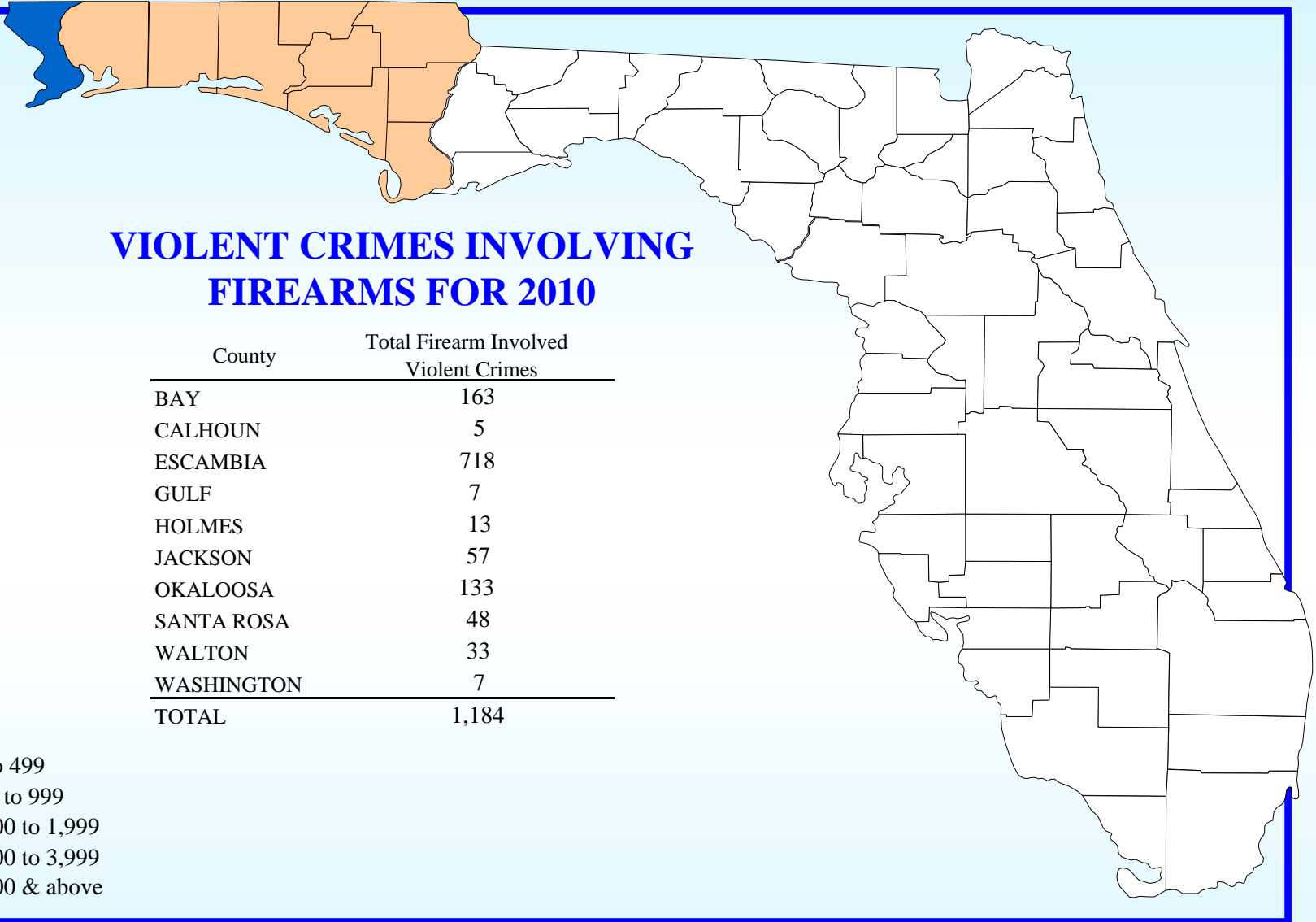

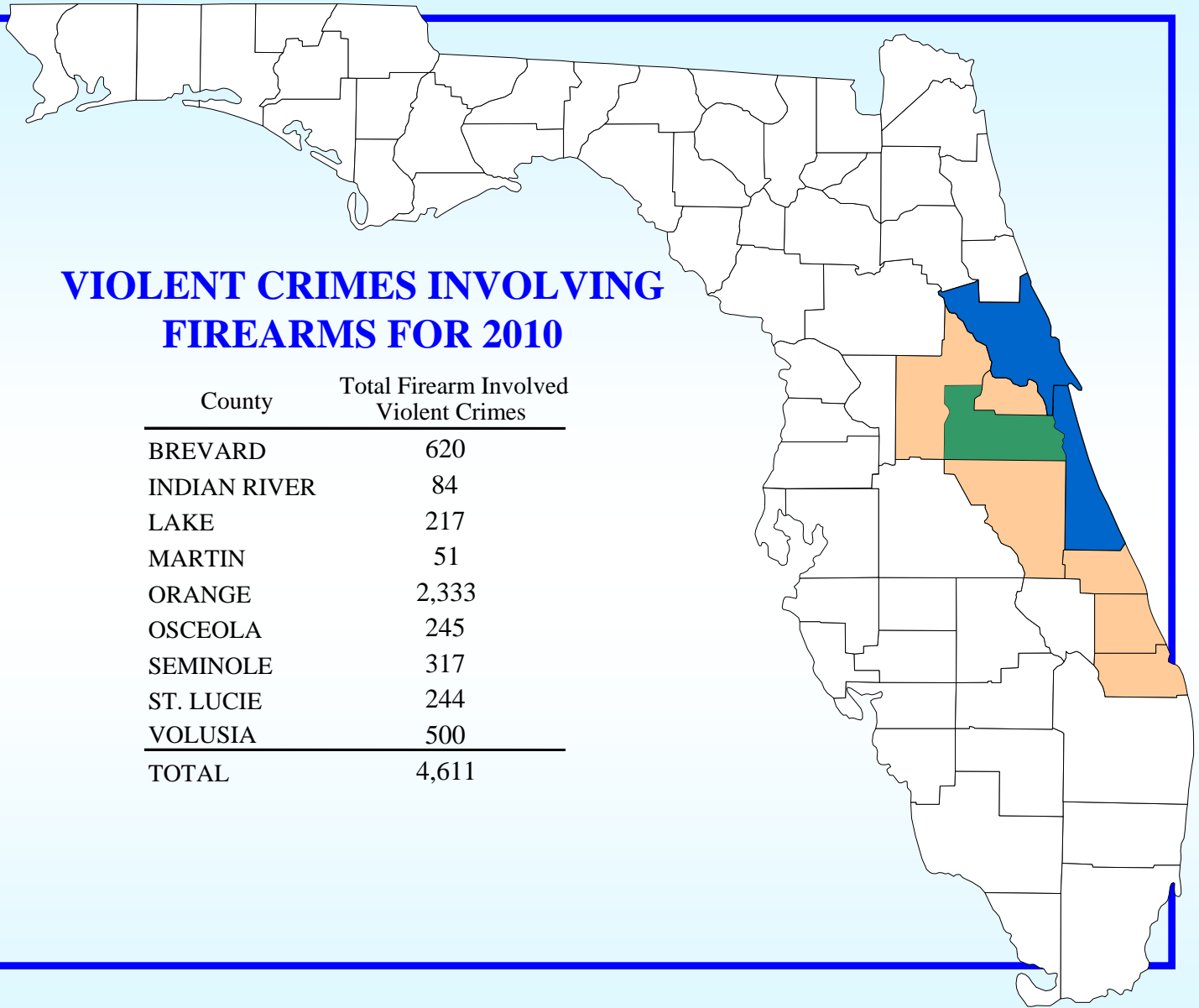

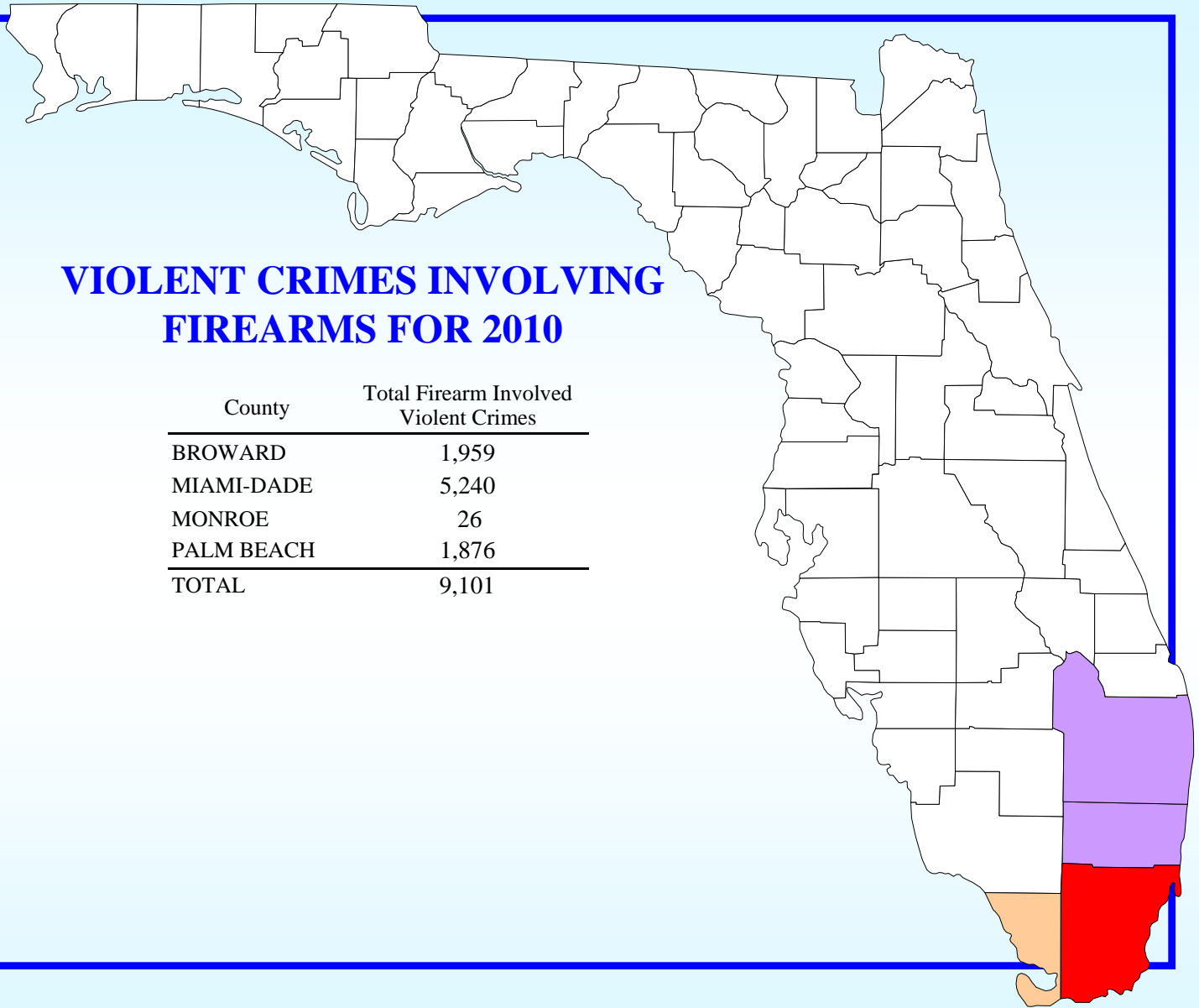

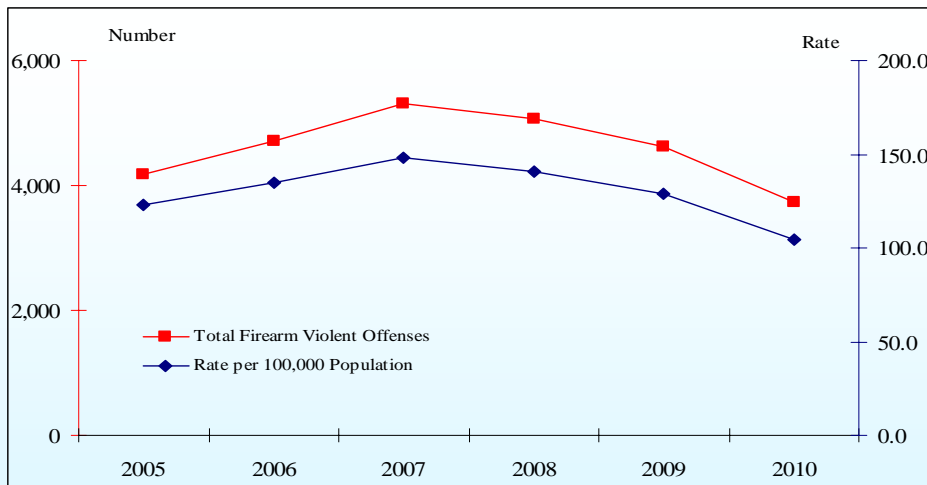
