

Firearm Involved Violent Crimes

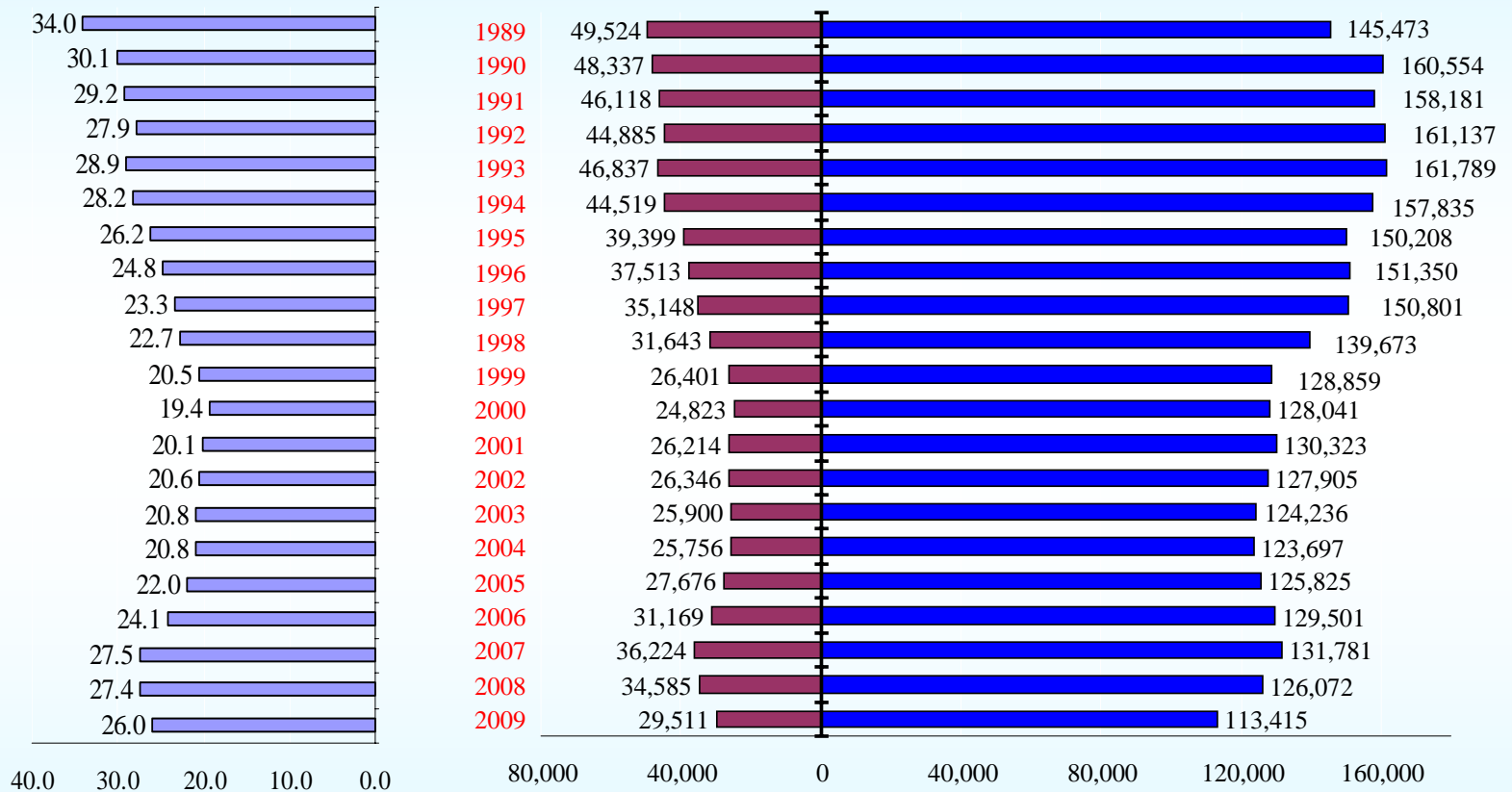
In 2009, a total of 29,511 Violent Index offenses involving a firearm were reported in Florida. More than 74 percent of those crimes occurred in ten counties (Brevard, Broward, Miami-Dade, Duval, Escambia, Hillsborough, Lee, Orange, Palm Beach, and Pinellas). These ten counties hold almost 60 percent of Florida's population.

Special emphasis continues to be placed on the identification, apprehension, prosecution, and imprisonment of those criminals who use firearms in the course of their illegal activities.

This presentation highlights the distribution of firearm related violent offenses in the State.



Florida Violent Offenses and Firearm Involved Violent Offenses 1989 - 2009



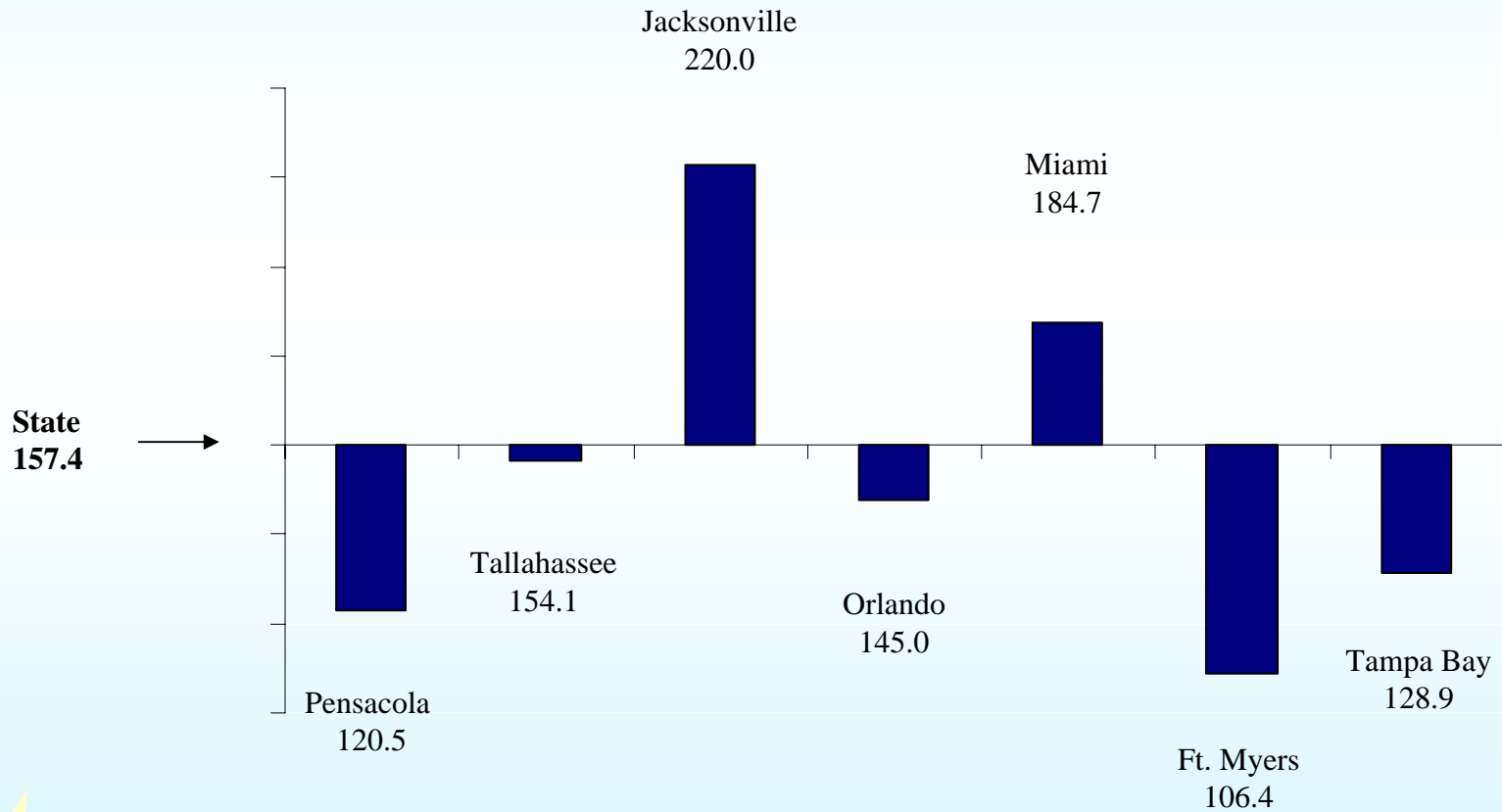
Percentage of Violent Offenses Committed with Firearms

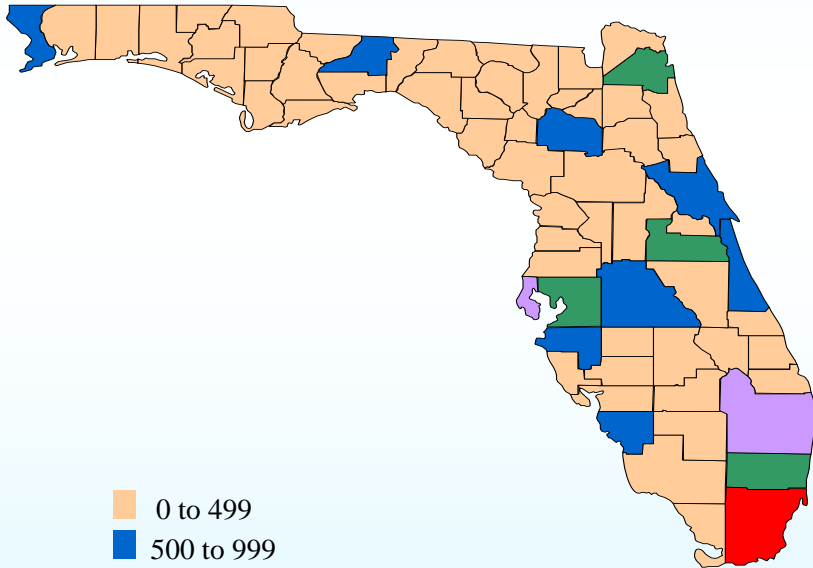


Comparison of Firearm Involved Violent Crime for State and FDLE Regions by Rate per 100,000 Population, 2009

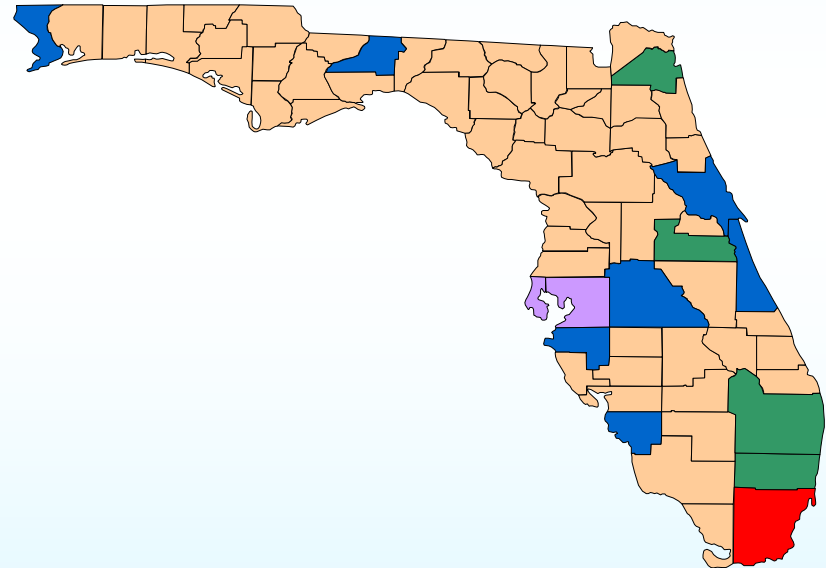

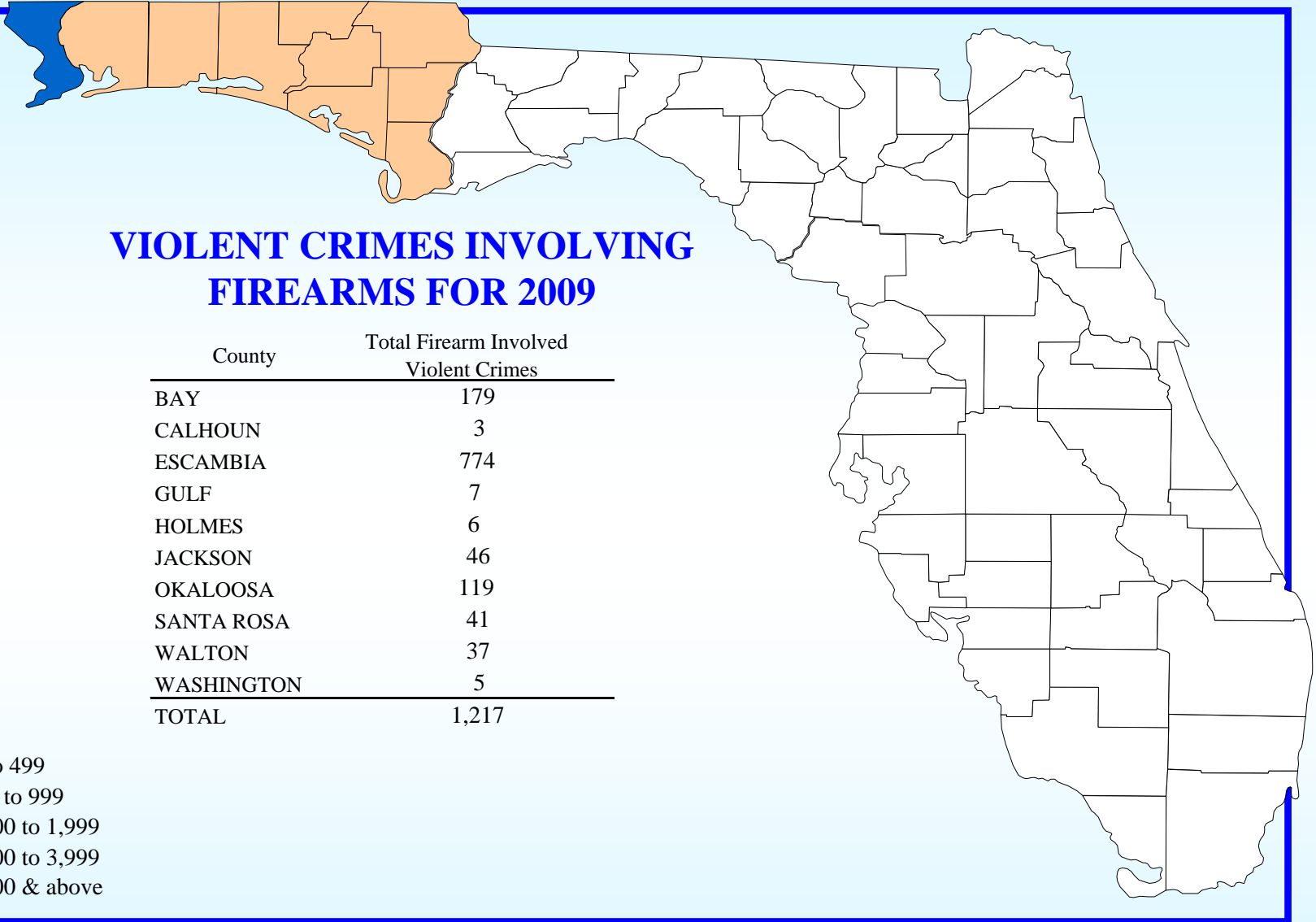

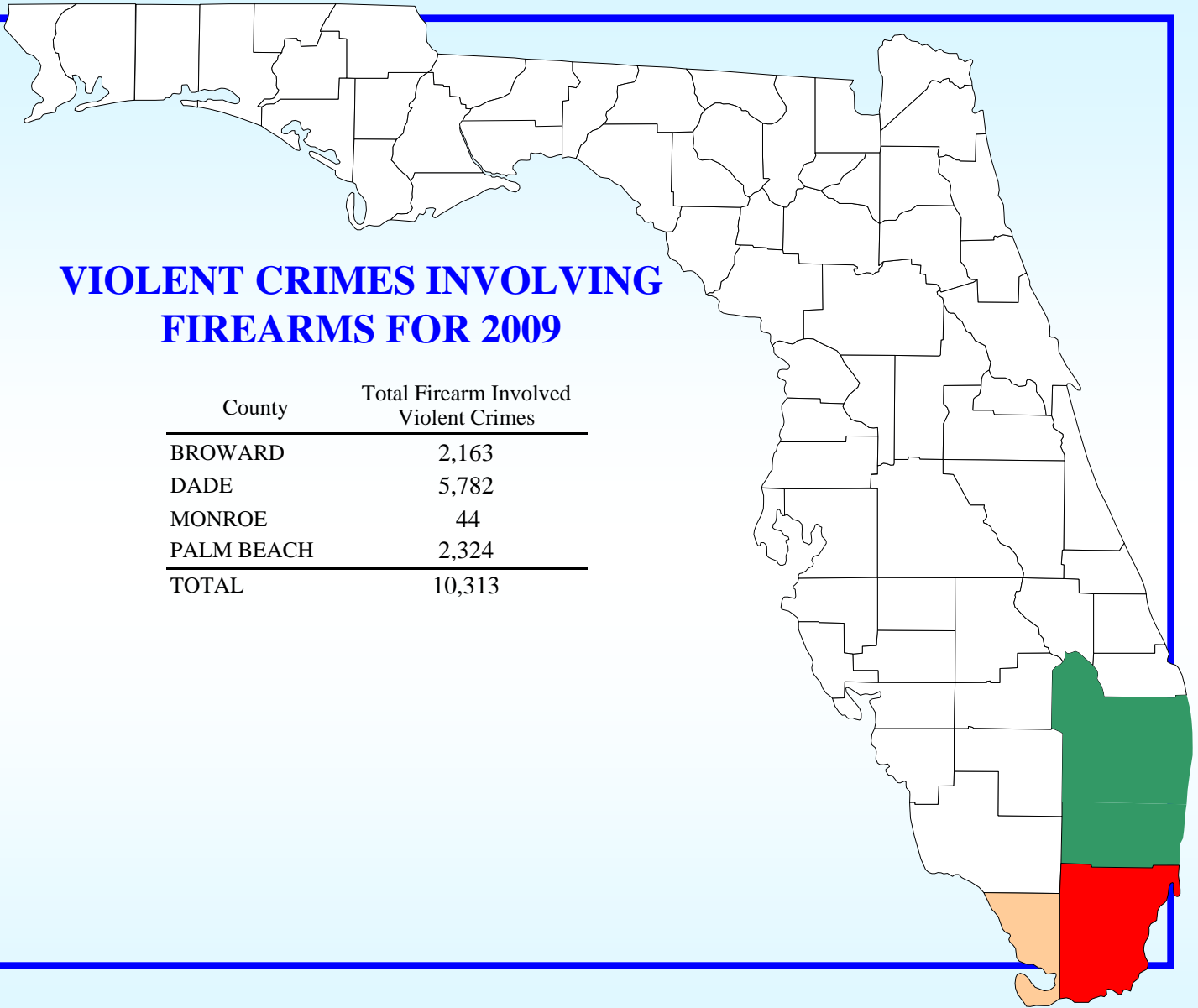

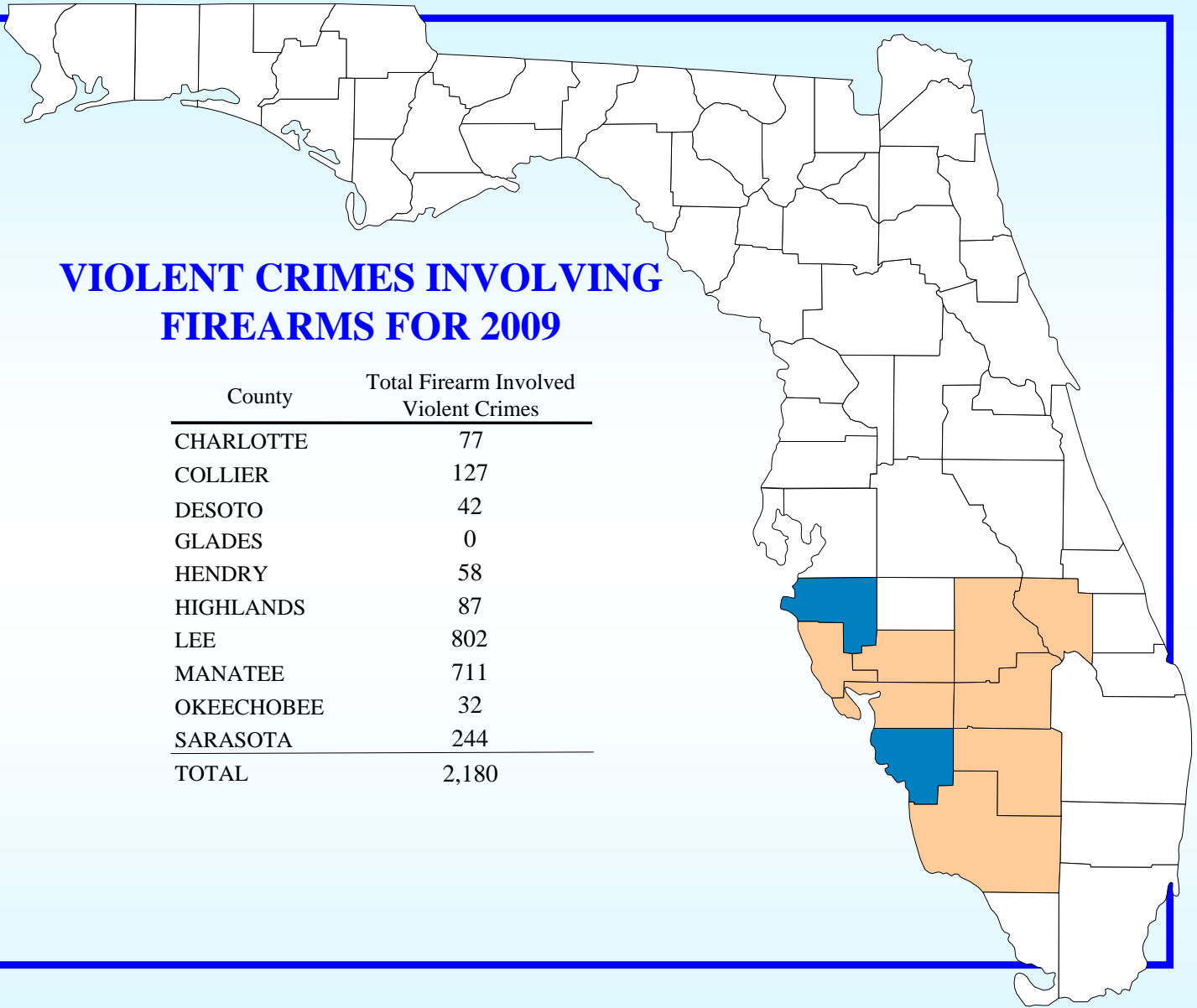

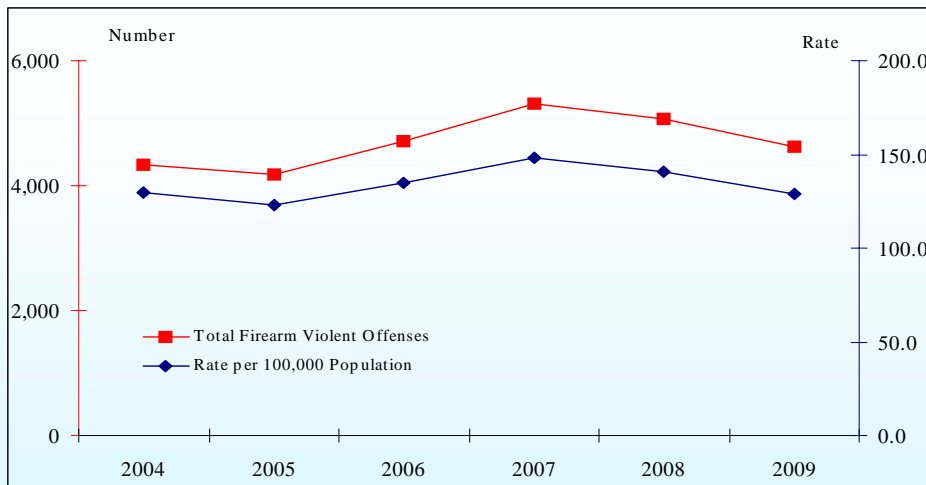
