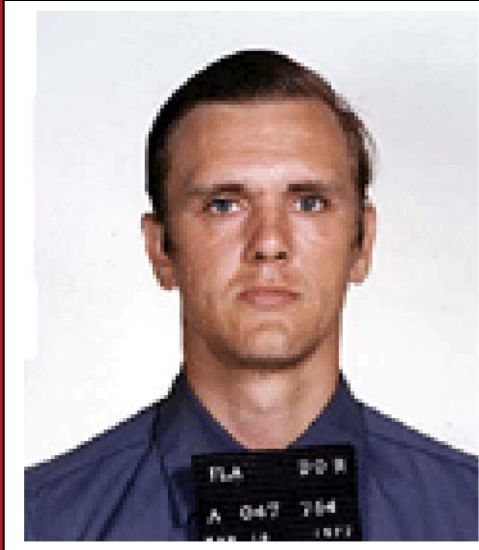

Glen Stark Chambers

Chambers escaped from the Polk Correctional Institution in 1990 by concealing himself in a truck that was leaving the facility. Chambers used tools to get out of the truck and escaped before the driver was aware he was there.

Authorities say Chambers has been spotted in Orange Beach and Perdido Key, Ala. Chambers may be in the Minnesota area.

Chambers was found guilty of first-degree murder on May 29, 1975 for the beating death of his girlfriend Connie Weeks. On Jan. 22, 1975, Chambers went to the Sarasota Lanes Bowling Alley. Weeks arrived shortly after Chambers. When she arrived, Chambers pulled her from the car and began assaulting her. An off-duty officer intervened and Chambers began fighting the officer. Chambers was arrested for simple battery. Weeks bonded Chambers out of jail that night and was beaten unconscious by Chambers within hours of his release. Weeks died five days later. Chambers was arrested and convicted of first-degree murder.

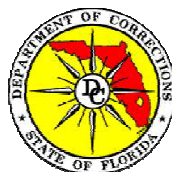
