

Firearm Involved Violent Crimes

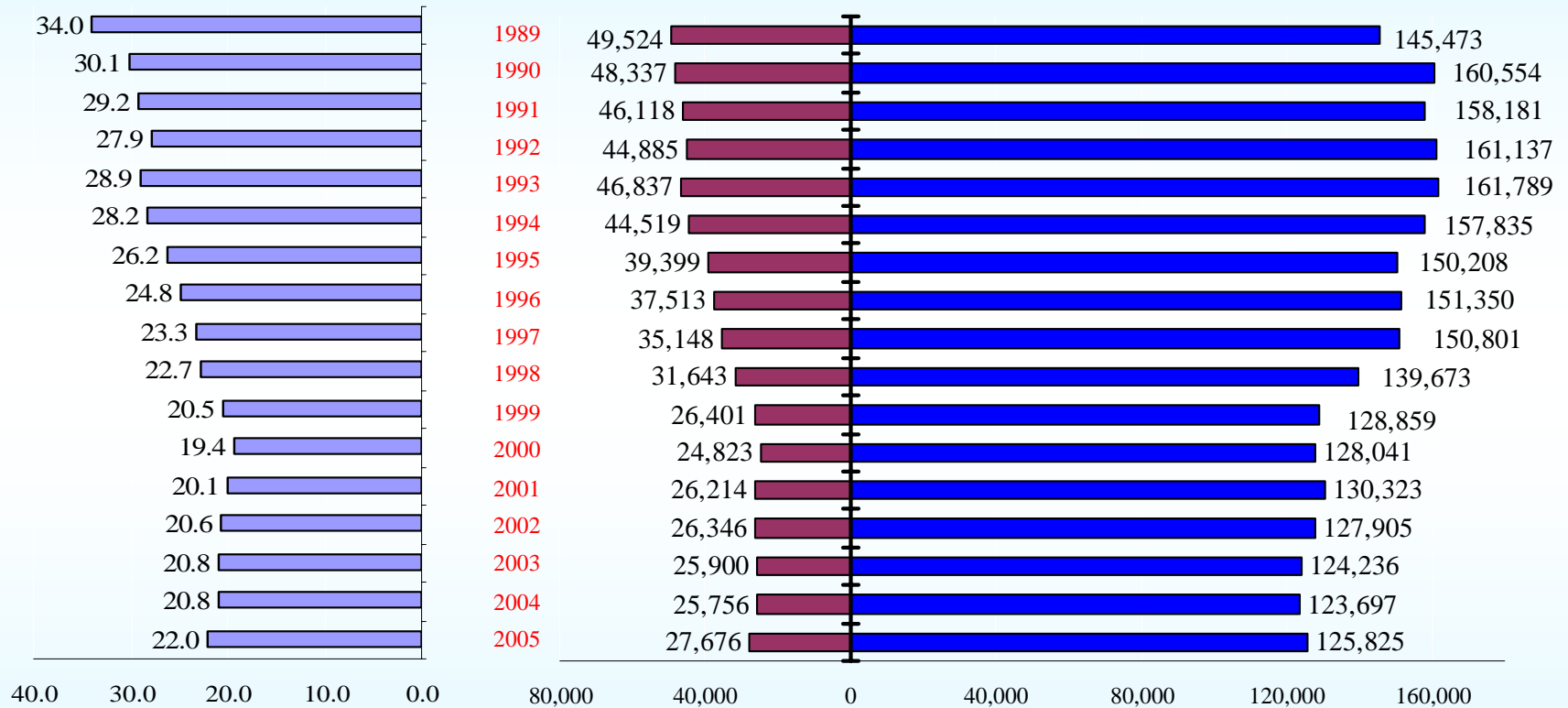
In 2005, a total of 27,676 Violent Index offenses involving a firearm were reported in Florida. More than 78 percent of those crimes occurred in ten counties (Brevard, Broward, Miami-Dade, Duval, Hillborough, Lee, Orange, Palm Beach, Pinellas, and Polk). These ten counties hold a little less than 62 percent of Florida's population.

Special emphasis continues to be placed on the identification, apprehension, prosecution, and imprisonment of those criminals who use firearms in the course of their illegal activities.

This presentation highlights the distribution of firearm related violent offenses in the State.



Florida Violent Offenses and Firearm Involved Violent Offenses 1989 - 2005



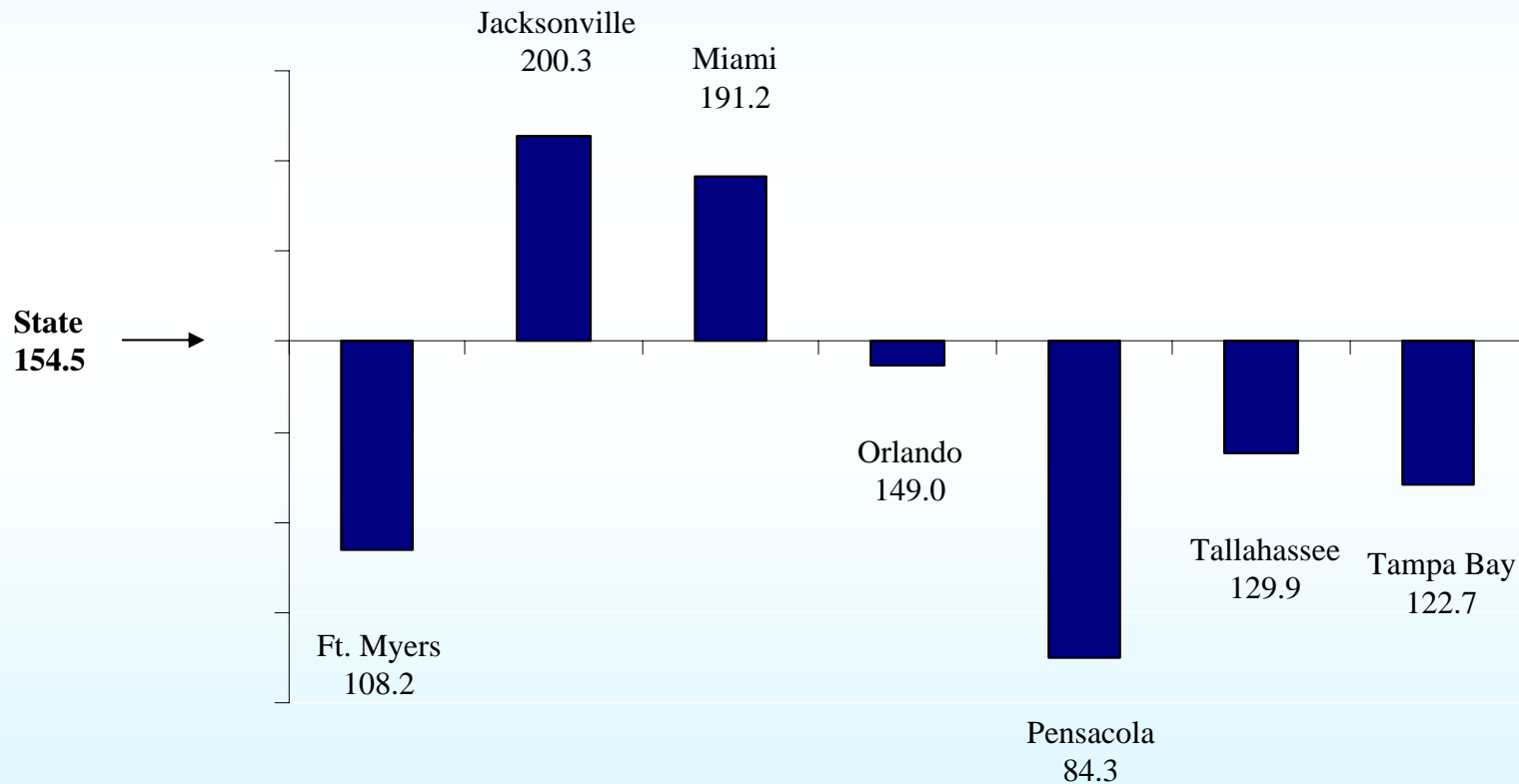
Percentage of Violent Offenses Committed with Firearms

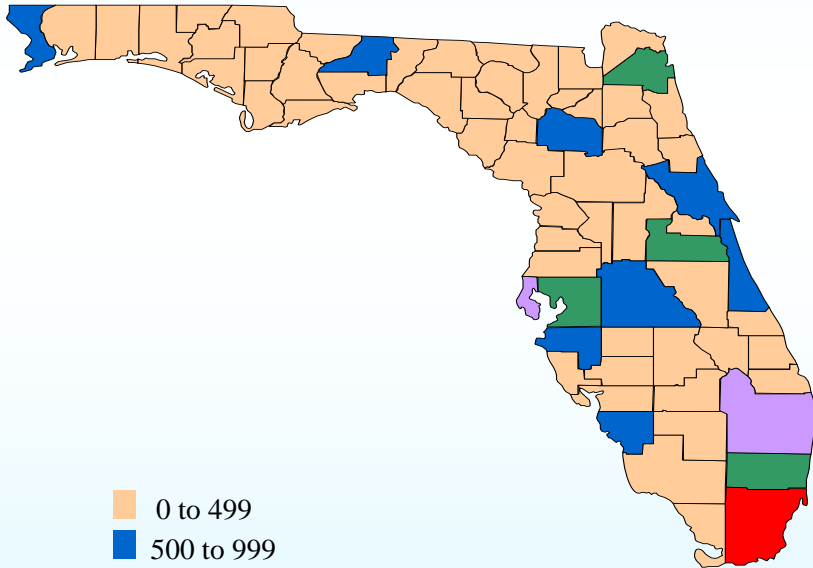


Comparison of Firearm Involved Violent Crime for State and FDLE Regions by Rate per 100,000 Population, 2005

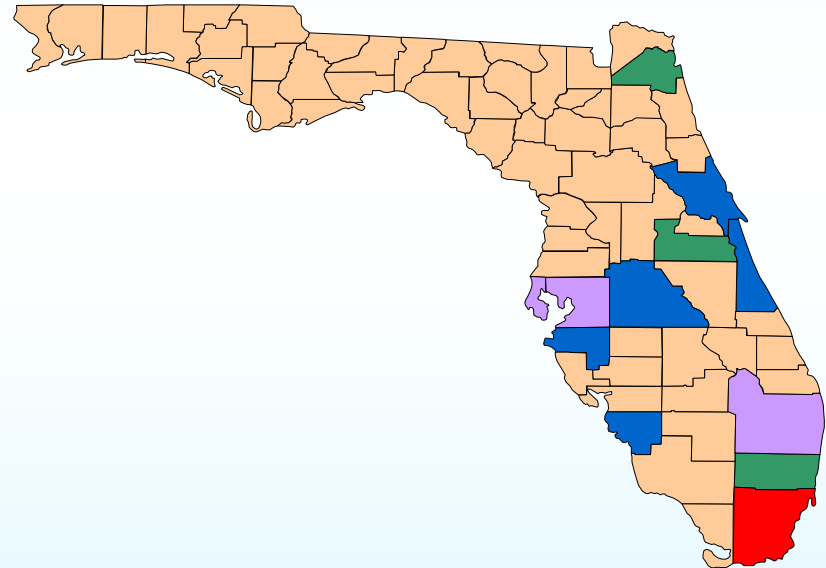

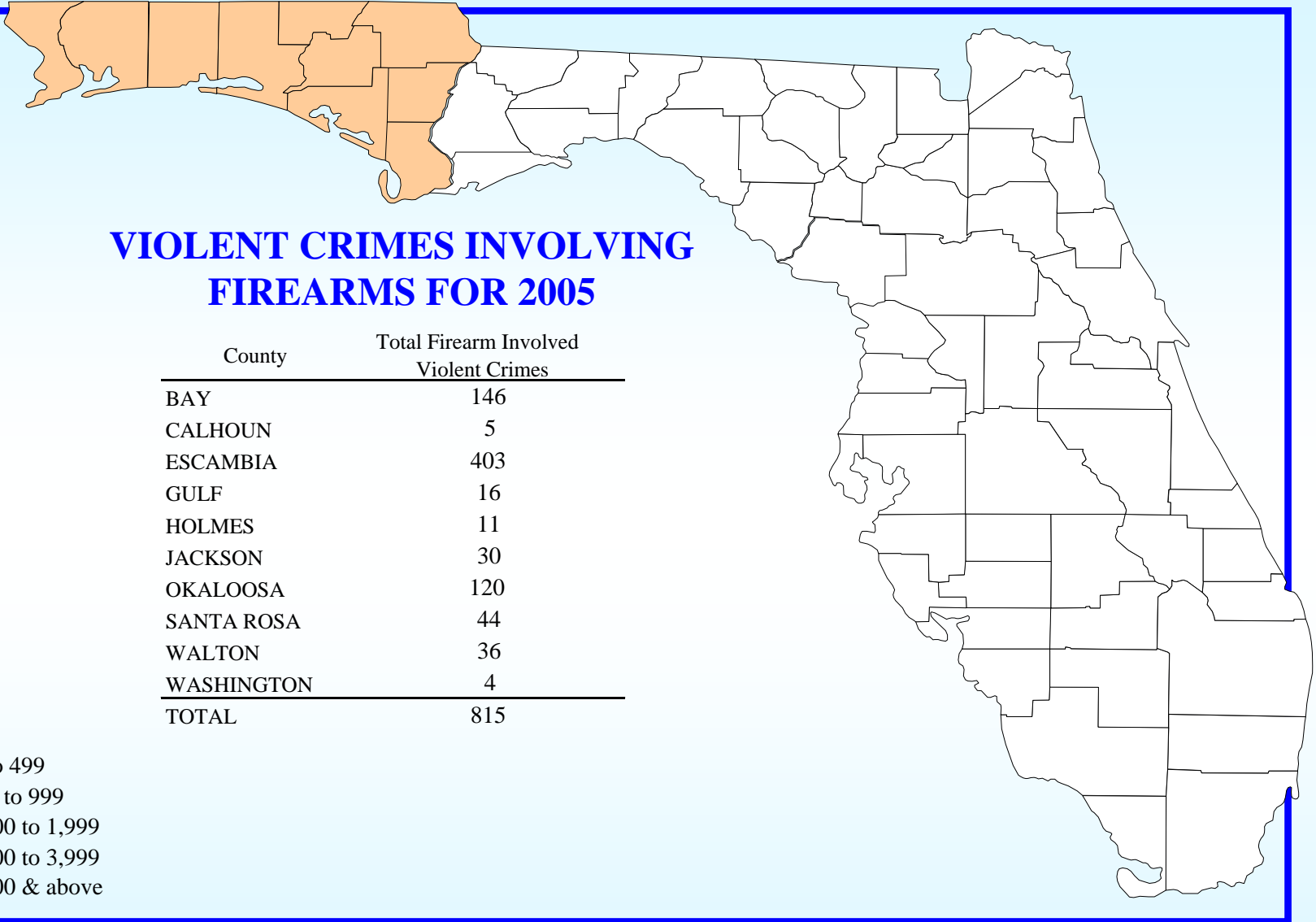

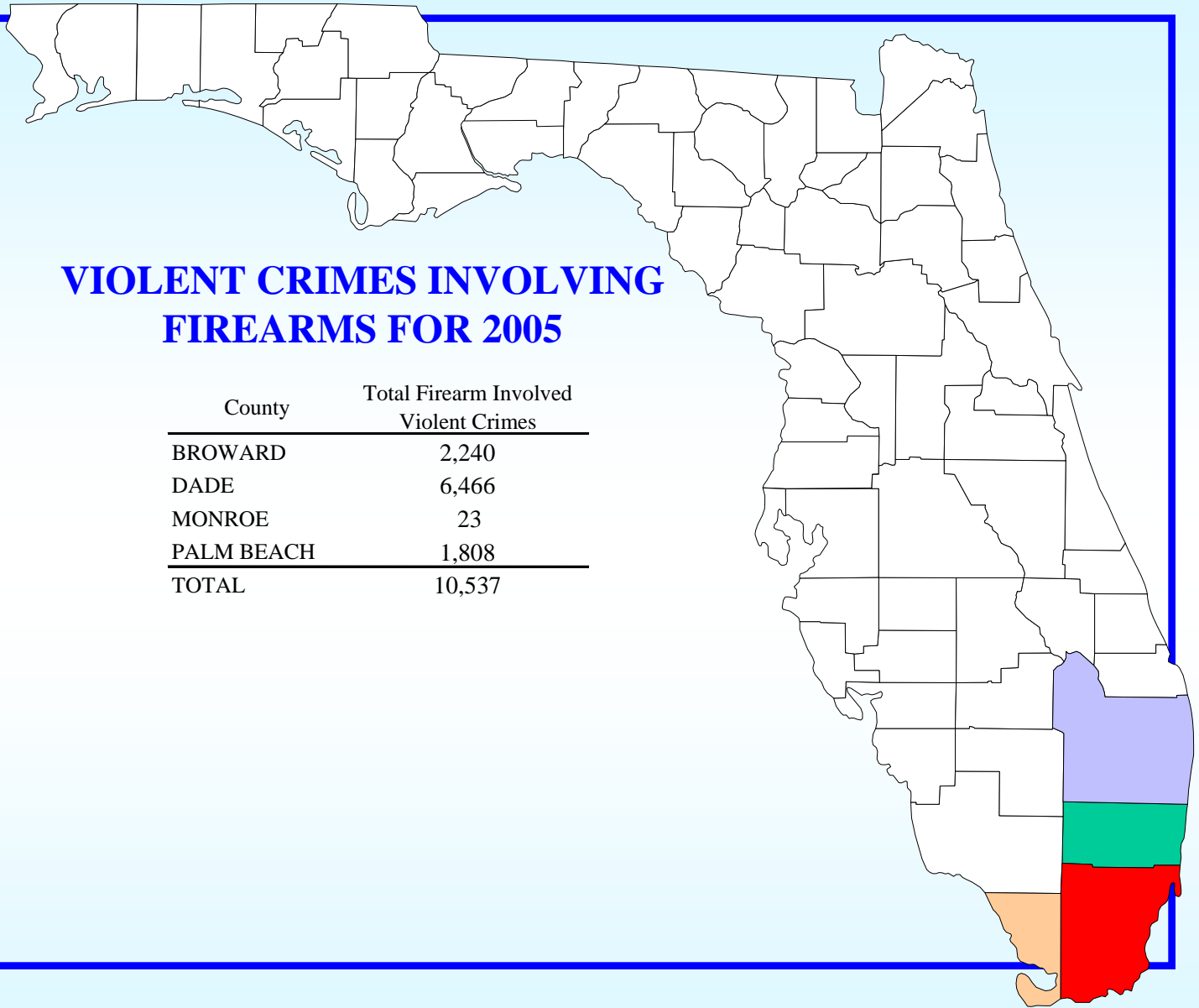

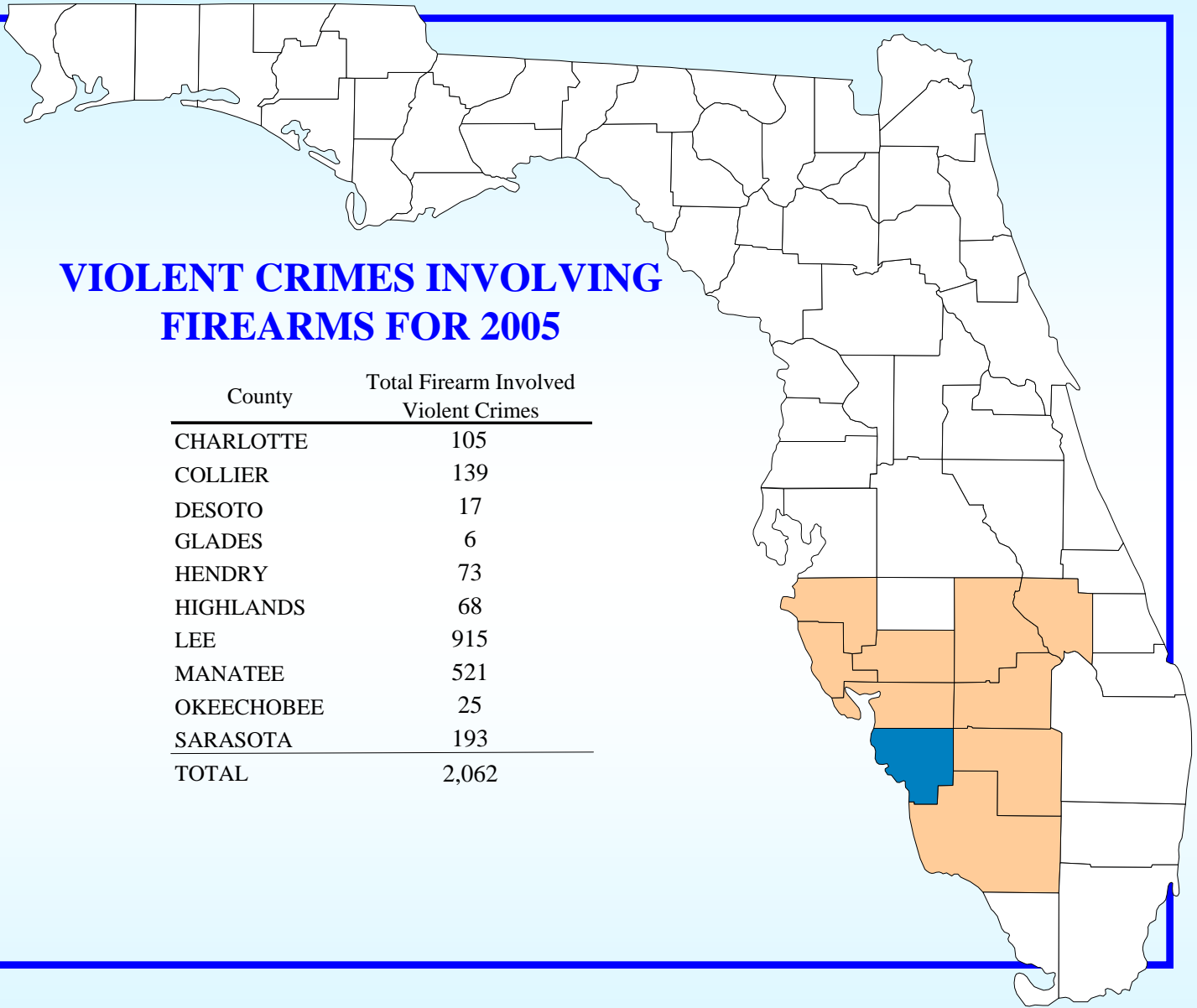

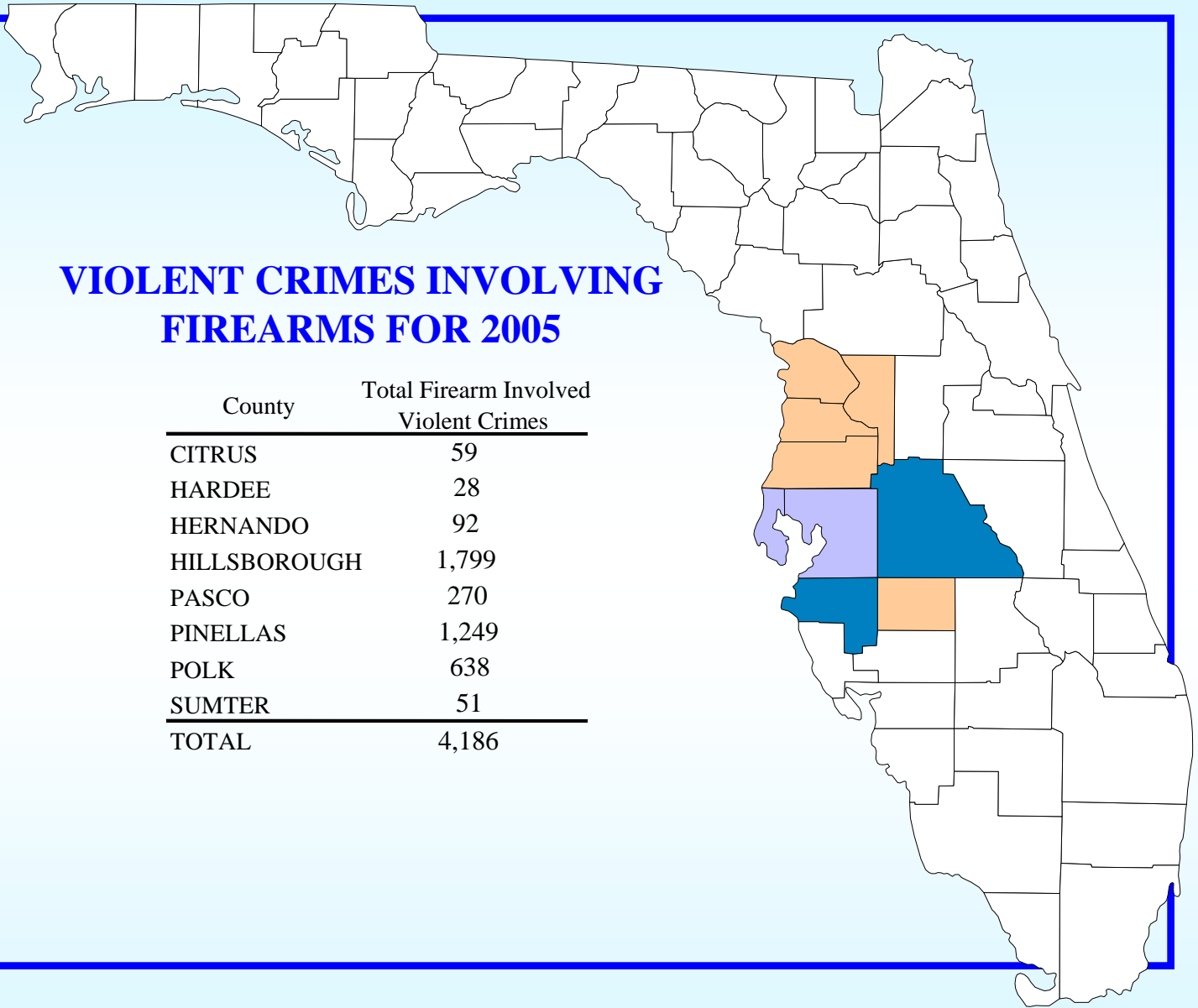

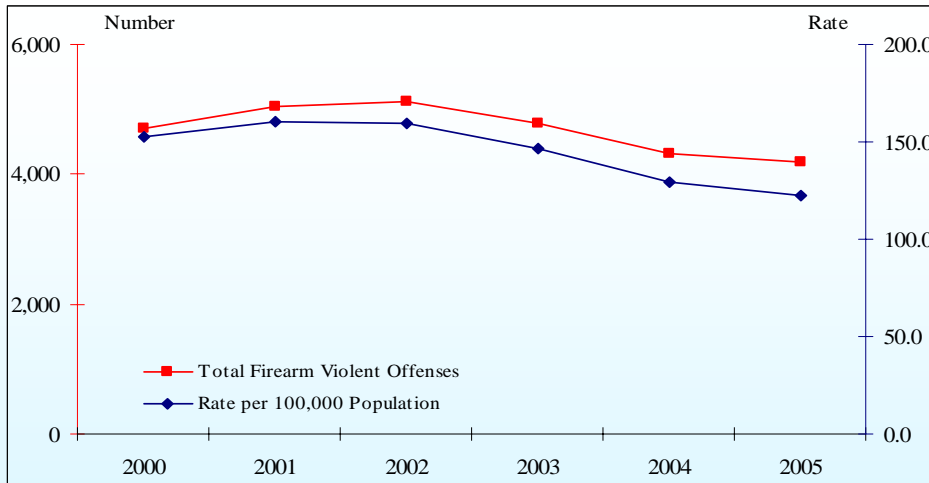
