

BREAKING AND ENTERING — BURGLARY

1982 — SUMMARY ANALYSIS

A total of 211,916 burglaries was reported by law enforcement agencies for the year 1982.

Burglaries accounted for 31.0 percent of all nonviolent crimes and 27.3 percent of all index offenses reported.

The burglary rate for the reporting period was 2,042.5 per 100,000 population.

There were 36,732 burglaries cleared by arrest or exceptionally cleared. This amounts to a clearance rate of 17.3 percent statewide.

The age group accounting for the highest percentage of persons arrested for burglary, 11.8 percent, occurred in the 25-29 age category. Males accounted for 94.4 percent of persons arrested for burglary.

Of all persons arrested for burglary, 63.7 percent were white, 36.1 percent were black and 0.2 percent were of other races.

Of the three categories of burglary, forcible entry was the most prevalent, with 159,859 offenses. This figure represents 75.4 percent of the total burglaries committed. Unlawful entry (no force) accounted for 15.6 percent, while 9.0 percent were attempts.

The value of property stolen in actual offenses of burglary totaled \$190,023,914 or 33.4 percent of the total value of property stolen during the year.

Residential burglaries accounted for 63.3 percent of the total offenses reported, with a total dollar loss of \$121,791,509. Where time could be determined, 46.2 percent of residential burglaries occurred during the night hours.
