Awareness and Prevention Committee (1:00 – 2:00 PM)

- **Craig Schroeder (CS):** We will begin by asking if there are any new items for review?

 - **Julie Collins (JC):** I know that DOE has personal safety curriculum and very few are abduction specific. There may be more out there.

Proposed Amendment: *Establish best practice standards for curriculum and materials for law enforcement to educate vulnerable populations about specific and potential dangers in online and texting platforms.*

 - **CS:** The other question was about any training announcements.
 - **CS:** Brett let me know that the last two CART teams would be certified by the beginning of November.
- **JP:** Next I want to ask Stephanie for an update on the online academy training material.
