Original fingerprint cards are preferred. If an original card is not available, a photographic copy may be submitted. Please ensure that the National Crime Information Center Number, Medical Examiner Case Number, Agency Case Number, and descriptors of the unidentified person are included on the card. All fingerprint cards will be returned to you.

Cards should be mailed to FDLE at the address below. FDLE can conduct a search of state (FDLE) missing person files, unsolved latent fingerprint files, and national (FBI) missing person fingerprint files. If an identification is made, you will be contacted via telephone immediately. FDLE will prioritize processing of these unidentified decedent requests.
