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1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 MR. GUALTIERI: All right. I've still got a  
3 bad echo, though. But we'll try this anyway.

4 (BACKGROUND CONVERSATION.)

5 MR. GUALTIERI: Can you hear me?

6 MS. UZZELL: You have to unmute so that I can  
7 hear him.

8 (BRIEF PAUSE.)

9 MS. UZZELL: Yes, sir, we can hear you.

10 MR. GUALTIERI: Okay. All right. So we will  
11 go ahead and call the meeting to order. And what  
12 we're going to do is we said in the e-mail that we  
13 sent is go ahead and ask Jennifer or Christina,  
14 whoever wants to do it, to call roll of the  
15 comission members --

16 (BACKGROUND CONVERSATION.)

17 MR. GUALTIERI: -- so that we know that we  
18 have a quorum. And then from there we will move  
19 into the rest of the agenda.

20 One of the things that I do want to say now  
21 to anybody who is not a commission member who is  
22 listening and wants to make any public comment,  
23 which we are required to offer by the law, is that  
24 you have to e-mail the request to  
25 jennifermiller2@FDLE.state.fl.us because when we

1 get to that portion of public comment if you  
2 haven't e-mailed your "ask to make public comment"  
3 to her before we get to that point, we will not  
4 know that you want to make public comment --

5 (BACKGROUND CONVERSATION.)

6 MR. GUALTIERI: -- we will not be able to move  
7 forward with that opportunity. For right now,  
8 Donna, if you would -- whoever is going to do it,  
9 have somebody call roll of the commission members.

10 MS. UZZELL: Unmute, please. Stand by and  
11 Jennifer has the roll call.

12 MS. MILLER: Okay. Good morning. I have  
13 Sheriff Gualtieri.

14 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

15 MS. MILLER: I can see him on here.

16 MS. UZZELL: Okay.

17 MS. MILLER: Chief Lystad, are you on?

18 MR. LYSTAD: I am here.

19 MS. MILLER: Sheriff Ashley, I don't believe  
20 he's -- Sheriff Ashley I don't think --

21 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

22 MS. MILLER: Chief State Attorney Bruce  
23 Bartlett?

24 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

25 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Blackburn?

1 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

2 MS. MILLER: I heard Senator Book on the  
3 line.

4 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

5 MS. MILLER: I'm sorry. Do you want me to  
6 just keep calling them?

7 MS. UZZELL: Keep calling them.

8 MS. MILLER: Mike Carroll, Commissioner  
9 Carroll?

10 MR. CARROLL: Mike Carroll here.

11 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Douglas Dodd?

12 MR. DODD: Dodd is here.

13 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Harpring?

14 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

15 MS. MILLER: I heard Sheriff Judd on.

16 UNKNOWN SPEAKER: Yeah, I can't

17 (INDISCERNIBLE) on the line.

18 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Larkin-Skinner?

19 MS. UZZELL: Can you just use --

20 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

21 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Nelson?

22 MR. NELSON: Here.

23 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Petty?

24 MR. PETTY: I'm here.

25 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Powers?

1 MS. POWERS: Here.

2 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Schachter?

3 MR. SCHACHTER: I'm here.

4 MS. MILLER: Commissioner Swearingen?

5 (NO RESPONSE.)

6 MS. MILLER: We know he's on.

7 Commissioner Stewart?

8 (NO RESPONSE.)

9 MS. MILLER: Secretary Kapusta?

10 MS. UZZELL: She will not be here.

11 MS. MILLER: Oh, Secretary Niermann?

12 MR. NIERMANN: Present, I'm here.

13 MS. MILLER: And Secretary Senior?

14 MR. BLACKBURN: I haven't heard you call

15 Vincent Blackburn.

16 MS. MILLER: Okay. I have -- I will mark you

17 off, Commissioner Blackburn. And I'm -- I need --

18 is Commissioner Bartlett on the line?

19 MR. BARTLETT: Sure am.

20 MS. MILLER: Okay.

21 MS. BOOK: Senator Book is on the line, but I

22 didn't hear you call me either. I apologize.

23 MS. MILLER: What about Commissioner

24 Larkin-Skinner?

25 MS. LARKIN-SKINNER: I'm here.

1 MS. MILLER: And Commissioner Harpring?

2 MS. LINDON: He answered.

3 MR. HARPRING: Yes, I'm present and on the  
4 line.

5 MS. MILLER: The last one I have is Secretary  
6 Senior.

7 MS. STEWART: Pam Stewart is here as well.

8 MS. UZZELL: Sorry, Commissioner.

9 MS. MILLER: Okay. I'm going to mute  
10 everyone and turn it back over to Sheriff  
11 Gualtieri.

12 MS. UZZELL: And please keep your lines on  
13 mute. Whoever is now on mute seems to be helping  
14 the situation. So --

15 MR. GUALTIERI: Okay. I just want to make  
16 sure that FDLE -- Donna, can you all hear me?

17 MS. UZZELL: Yes.

18 MR. GUALTIERI: Okay. All right. And so  
19 just so we have because -- so the record is clear,  
20 which commissioners do we not have on the line?

21 MS. MILLER: We do not have Sheriff Ashley,  
22 Kapusta, or Secretary Senior.

23 MR. GUALTIERI: Okay. Thank you. All right.  
24 So the next order of business on the agenda is the  
25 minutes from the December meeting. I know Sheriff

1 Judd that you had a request to change, we'll talk  
2 about that.

3 But first, before we get into the discussion  
4 on that, do we have a motion to approve the  
5 December meeting --

6 MS. UZZELL: You have to unmute.

7 MR. GUALTIERI: -- minutes?

8 MR. JUDD: Motion by Judd.

9 MR. BLACKBURN: Second made by Blackburn.

10 MR. GUALTIERI: Okay. Commissioner Blackburn  
11 is second. So we have a motion, we have a second.  
12 Discussion?

13 And Sheriff Judd requested a change that  
14 reflects the motion that was made during  
15 the meeting --

16 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

17 MS. UZZELL: Oh.

18 MR. GUALTIERI: -- regarding the -- regarding  
19 the -- the language regarding the volunteers  
20 that's already in the -- the staff that wasn't  
21 volunteers, but it was those who volunteer. And I  
22 believe, Jennifer, that you've made that change as  
23 requested by Sheriff Judd, correct?

24 MS. MILLER: Yes, sir, Christina Lindon made  
25 it this morning and that's what will be posted



1           online.

2           MR. GUALTIERI:   Okay.   So just for the  
3           commission members there will be a change in the  
4           order of the words.

5           Does anybody else have any other discussion,  
6           or comments, or revisions on the meeting of  
7           minutes from December?

8           (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

9           MR. GUALTIERI:   It sounds like somebody is  
10          trying.

11          MS. MILLER:   Everyone is unmuted.

12          MS. UZZELL:   Everyone is unmute?

13          MS. MILLER:   Unmute.

14          MR. GUALTIERI:   With that, if anybody has any  
15          other topics, please try again or all in favor of  
16          motion signify by saying aye.

17          (CHORUS OF AYES.)

18          MR. GUALTIERI:   Any opposed, same?

19          (NO RESPONSE.)

20          MR. GUALTIERI:   So the meeting minutes we  
21          vote -- requested by Sheriff Judd passes.   And we  
22          will go ahead and get a final copy to everybody.

23          All right.   So moving on now into the next  
24          agenda item, which is the report that -- you all  
25          received a copy of the final version of the

1 initial report a couple of days ago. We certainly<sup>10</sup>  
2 appreciate everyone working with us.

3 As I said, I know that this has been an  
4 ongoing day and night effort over the last few  
5 weeks to get this to the point where it is. We  
6 have continued since we sent it out to you -- we  
7 have continued to make changes to it, but none of  
8 them are substantive, they are cleaning it up,  
9 grammar, typos, those types of things.

10 So what we have substantively is the final  
11 version of the initial report so with that we can  
12 have discussion about it, but I think it's  
13 appropriate, first, if we have a motion to approve  
14 the final version of the initial report and if we  
15 have that and a second then we will open it up for  
16 a discussion.

17 So do we have a motion to approve the final  
18 version?

19 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

20 MR. HARPRING: (INDISCERNIBLE) approved.

21 MR. DODD: Second.

22 MR. GUALTIERI: Okay. Who is the second?

23 MR. DODD: This is Doug Dodd.

24 MR. GUALTIERI: Okay. So the motion to  
25 approve by Commissioner Harpring and the second by

1 Commissioner Dodd. So do we have any discussion  
2 of --

3 UNKNOWN SPEAKER: You can try it and see.

4 MR. GUALTIERI: -- motion regarding the  
5 approved or the initial?

6 MR. SCHACHTER: Yes, it's Schachter.

7 MR. GUALTIERI: Go ahead.

8 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

9 MR. SCHACHTER: Again, I just want to thank  
10 you Sheriff, and all of your staff, and the FDLE  
11 for the tremendous job that they have done in the  
12 short period of time that (AUDIO FEEDBACK). And,  
13 you know, for all of the hours, and hours away,  
14 and the staff is away from their families to get  
15 this done.

16 And the 17 families wanted to get to the  
17 bottom of what happened on February 14th and I  
18 think that we have done that.

19 With that said, I think that this report is a  
20 very, very good product. There is some issues  
21 that I still want to go into more detail and I  
22 know that we will do that in the coming years, so  
23 thank you very much for everything that everyone  
24 has done. And all the Commissioners devoting all  
25 the time and travel, thank you very much from the

1 17.

2 MR. GUALTIERI: All right. Thank you Mr.  
3 Schachter. You're absolutely right, we're -- like  
4 you said our work is not done; we have a lot to do  
5 ahead of us. This is just the beginning of a  
6 initial product. We all hope that it has an  
7 impact and it helps to move the needle where it  
8 needs to go.

9 Does anybody else have any -- does anybody  
10 else have any discussion on the motion?

11 MR. GUALTIERI: So I sent an e-mail, most all  
12 of you have seen everything that was in the  
13 report, except for the preface, which was new, and  
14 -- but everything else that you've seen in it  
15 includes all of your revisions for the December  
16 meeting. So if there are no additional comments  
17 or discussion on the motion, we will call a vote  
18 on the motion.

19 All of those in favor of the --

20 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

21 UNKNOWN SPEAKER: I say not.

22 (CHORUS OF AYES.)

23 MR. GUALTIERI: Any opposed, same?

24 (NO RESPONSE.)

25 MR. GUALTIERI: And so motion to approve the

1 initial report passes unanimously. We will get it  
2 submitted to the Governor or we will provide a  
3 copy to the Governor-elect, and to the President  
4 of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House later  
5 today. Just because we are still in the process  
6 we wanted to make sure that we had the approval of  
7 the Commission before we totally finalized  
8 everything. But we should be able to get that  
9 over to them by the end of the day today.

10 So before we adjourn, do we have -- Jennifer,  
11 have you received anything regarding public  
12 comment?

13 MS. MILLER: We have not received any public  
14 comments.

15 MR. GUALTIERI: Okay. All right. So because  
16 just to reiterate --

17 (BACKGROUND CONVERSATION.)

18 MR. GUALTIERI: -- Mr. Schachter's comments,  
19 and I too I know we -- all of us on the entire  
20 Commission want to thank everybody who was  
21 instrumental -- there were so many people. We're  
22 not going to start tracking any names, but they  
23 are instrumental in bringing this to fruition over  
24 the last, you know, almost nine months now, but,  
25 especially, in the last several weeks of bringing

1           this report to its culmination point.

2           And there are literally many people that have  
3           worked day and night and we truly appreciate the  
4           effort on the work and know that it is meaningful  
5           and it will be meaningful and this will make a  
6           difference as far as the kids in Florida are  
7           concerned -- the schools in Florida are concerned.

8           And I thank all of the commission members for  
9           your work, and your time, your dedication over the  
10          last five months. And we've got a lot of work to  
11          do ahead of us and as many questions as we  
12          answered, it has now raised new questions and  
13          there is a lot that we need to explore. And we  
14          will get this report filed today and then soon we  
15          will get back in touch. And as I said, probably  
16          the next e-mail that you are going to receive is  
17          -- is a request from you all to tell us what you  
18          think are those open questions and those areas  
19          that need follow up.

20          And we will go ahead and try to get our next  
21          meeting scheduled, you know, sometime -- most  
22          likely it -- most likely it will be in March. We  
23          are having trouble with a venue any earlier than  
24          that.

25          And I think that we need time to be able to

1           conduct the investigation and as we did in the  
2           past, and then be able to put on a substantive  
3           meeting. So I kind of see that as the -- the  
4           tentative game plan.

5           We don't want to allow too much time, but we  
6           need to give, you know, the investigators a little  
7           bit of a break here and the staff and time to  
8           prepare for the next meeting, so we will be back  
9           in touch -- or in the very near future seeking  
10          your feedback and comments on where we go from  
11          here.

12          And so unless anybody has anything else, we  
13          will adjourn the meeting. Does any of the  
14          Commissioners have anything else?

15                 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

16          MR. DODD: (INDISCERNIBLE) the quicker we can  
17          get the dates then we can project them up through  
18          the year.

19                 (BACKGROUND CONVERSATION.)

20          MR. GUALTIERI: Yeah, we will do that and get  
21          a plan for -- and I'll get it out to you as soon  
22          as we can. So we will be in touch soon.

23          MS. BOOK: Mr. Chair?

24          MR. GUALTIERI: Yes.

25          MS. BOOK: I apologize. This is Senator

1 Book. I -- my office has issues that have arisen  
2 from some of the work that we have done. I'm just  
3 sending it to you all and I'm assuming that while  
4 we are in our little break period that will be a  
5 meeting appropriate subject.

6 MR. GUALTIERI: Yes, it is. It's kind of  
7 hard to hear you.

8 (AUDIO FEEDBACK.)

9 MS. BOOK: I'm just forwarding those along to  
10 you --

11 MR. GUALTIERI: Yeah.

12 MS. BOOK: -- to have. And, you know, asking  
13 if you, Chair, deem appropriate that those be  
14 disseminated and if any issues that may come up  
15 that they are being handled in the that way.

16 MR. GUALTIERI: Yeah, that's great and that's  
17 fine. I mean, there are a lot of things and we're  
18 already starting a long list of follow-up items.  
19 There really is a lot that needs to be done and  
20 followed through.

21 So anything that you are getting, go ahead  
22 and forward it on and we will start compiling that  
23 and use the same methodology that we have that is  
24 to get people to look at this stuff and  
25 investigate it and send follow ups.



1           And we'll all be back together here hopefully  
2           within the next couple of months and we can get up  
3           the incline.

4           All right. Well, thank you very much,  
5           everybody. And again, thanks to everybody who --  
6           everybody for your participation in this.

7           And we know that they are all anxious to hear  
8           it and read what we have been able to put  
9           together. And we will be in touch in the near  
10          future. So with that we will go ahead and adjourn  
11          the meeting and thanks for calling in this  
12          morning.
