


## **Timeline for Communications System**

- Early 1980s-2014- Margate Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP)
- 2014- Regionalization of Broward County Communication System occurred
- 2017- Initiated comprehensive review of complaints
- 2019- Negotiations with City of Coral Springs and the City of Coconut Creek commenced to merge as a multi-city communications system hosted by Coral Springs.







### **A Sample of Communication Frustrations**

- Radio Channel Stops Working
- Non Emergency Phones not answered
- Holding priority calls
- Citizens frustrated with the call taking process
- Pertinent information not being given to officers or gathered from citizen
- Wrong location of where incident occurred (jurisdiction)
- Wrong address of incident given to first responder
- Officers assigned to the wrong active calls
