FDLE, in partnership with Florida's seven Regional Domestic Security Task Forces, has launched **BUSINES**SAFE to provide



businesses of all types and sizes with new tools to keep Florida safe. Businesses have the option of registering to receive electronic alert notifications

by email, cellular phones and PDAs. These alerts will provide information about breaking news, possible threats, suspicious activity, and specific preparedness and prevention techniques for your business.

**BUSINESSAFE** participants also receive access to a Web-based tool that offers industry specific fact sheets and important safety information.

Once signed up, businesses will be able to register with the United States Department of Homeland Security to access a Web site

which will provide vital information on protection from security breaches.



#### What is the purpose of BUSINESSAFE?

**BUSINESSAFE** is designed to arm Florida's businesses with relevant and timely domestic security information to help safeguard assets and protect local communities.
