

The Statewide Silver Alert is a plan to aid local law enforcement in the rescue or recovery of a missing elderly person who suffers from irreversible deterioration of intellectual faculties. The following is the monthly report for silver alerts issued at the state level when a vehicle was involved and dynamic messaging signs were activated. Local agencies are encouraged to issue regional or local alerts for persons meeting the criteria when a vehicle is not involved. This report only includes those issued by the FDLE Missing and Endangered Persons Information Clearinghouse where a vehicle was involved.
