

The Florida Silver Alert Plan is a tool which aids local law enforcement in the recovery of a missing senior who suffers from an irreversible deterioration of intellectual faculties. The Plan provides for activation of a State Silver Alert when a person meeting the criteria goes missing while driving a motor vehicle. Local agencies are encouraged to issue Local Silver Alerts for persons meeting the criteria when a vehicle is not involved. The following is a monthly report detailing State Silver Alerts issued by the FDLE Missing Endangered Persons Information Clearinghouse.

An **indirect recovery** is defined as a person recovered through the actions of the local agency in coordination with the Silver Alert Plan, primarily through law enforcement communications or media. All listed recovery information is as of January 1, 2014
