

WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERT (WEA)

- A WEA IS A MESSAGE SENT TO MOBILE DEVICES IN ORDER TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF AN EMERGENCY
- THERE ARE MULTIPLE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES THAT HAVE ACCESS TO SEND OUT A WEA- INCLUDING FDLE MEPIC
- FDLE MEPIC USES THE WEA TO INFORM THE PUBLIC WHEN A CHILD HAS BEEN KIDNAPPED OR IF A MISSING CHILD IS IN IMMINENT THREAT OF DEATH OR SERIOUS BODILY INJURY



WEA SUCCESS STORIES

A FLORIDA ENHANCED MISSING CHILD ALERT WAS ISSUED ON BEHALF OF THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR AN AUTISTIC, NON-VERBAL, 13-YEAR-OLD MALE. THE CHILD WAS RECOVERED SAFELY WHEN A CITIZEN RECOGNIZED THE MISSING CHILD FROM THE WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERT (WEA) AND NOTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT.

A FLORIDA AMBER ALERT WAS ISSUED ON BEHALF OF THE ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR A 1-YEAR-OLD MALE. THE CHILD WAS RECOVERED SAFELY WHEN A CITIZEN RECOGNIZED THE MISSING CHILD FROM THE AMBER ALERT AND NOTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT.

A FLORIDA ENHANCED MISSING CHILD ALERT WAS ISSUED ON BEHALF OF THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR AN AUTISTIC 13-YEAR-OLD FEMALE. THE CHILD WAS RECOVERED SAFELY WHEN A CITIZEN RECOGNIZED THE MISSING CHILD FROM THE WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERT (WEA) AND NOTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT.
