#### **AGENDA ITEM 1: RESOLUTION 2025-006 Local Law Enforcement Immigration Grant Program**

Chairman Judd presented this agenda item to the Council concerning an issue related to immigration enforcement. The focus of this agenda item was a resolution that would allow only designated transportation agencies to receive reimbursement for purchasing multi-passenger vans intended for the safe transport of unauthorized aliens who are in custody. He went on to clarify that all existing rules regarding equipment and travel reimbursements remain

unchanged as previously outlined. Additionally, Chairman Judd stated that this resolution will require a rule change to the current prohibition on reimbursing vehicles and invited any comments or questions from the council members and the members of the audience.

**COUNCIL ACTION:** Discussion was held and *Chief Dominguez moved to approve this agenda item; seconded by Chief Goerke; the motion carried.*
