Applicants to FLEAT must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be currently employed by a criminal justice agency.
2. Must currently hold a law enforcement analyst position, and must have held that position for at least one (1) year on the first day of the FLEAT class for which they are seeking admission.
3. Must have successfully completed the FDLE Core Analytical Training (FCAT) course, or have equivalent analyst training, prior to seeking admission to FLEAT.
4. Have successfully passed a background investigation by the nominee's employing agency consistent with background standards for criminal justice officers as detailed in Rule 11B-27.0022, F.A.C.
5. Must be provided access by their agency to a laptop computer (PCs only) with the following:
 - wi-fi enabled (agency-provided internet hotspot preferred)
 - Microsoft Office (other versions, including Office 365 or Office 2016 are not acceptable)
 - Microsoft Excel
 - Adobe Reader or Adobe Acrobat (ability to open Adobe documents)
 - ability to access Canvas to access course content
