Award criteria for non-sworn and sworn personnel:

- Award can be presented to anyone (victim, civilian, law enforcement officer, group, or task force team, etc.) who has or have made outstanding contributions to the issue of human trafficking;
- Work done must positively affect Florida missing and endangered children and their families and/or positively impact the safety of Florida's children;
- The individual(s) work must demonstrate a profound contribution that established improvements thus preventing children from human trafficking and/or safely recover those who go missing and were victims of human trafficking during the period of time from January 1, 2015 thru April 30, 2016.

Sworn nominee(s) must also meet the following criteria in addition to the above criteria. He/she must:

- 1. Have been a sworn, active law enforcement officer(s) during the case investigation;
- 2. Be employed in Florida and can work as a group of two or more people;
- 3. Be in good standing with his/her department;
- 4. Be in good standing with the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (CJSTC);
- 5. Have no departmental or other charges currently pending against him/her;
- 6. Have performed an investigative activity, during January 1, 2015 thru April 30, 2016, that can be determined to be exceptional, extraordinary, outstanding, or beyond the call of duty, and that such activity has resulted in the safe location or recovery of a missing child, who is a victim of human trafficking, or solved a case involving human trafficking; OR
- 7. Made a significant contribution to combatting human trafficking issues through the development and/or implementation of an educational, awareness, or safety program.

Note: All nominations will be vetted by FDLE. If a nominee is employed or nominated by a state or government agency, nominations must be submitted through the chain of command. If any disciplinary or legal action occurs after the nomination, the nomination or award may be withdrawn.
