Do you have notes on why the first inspection failed? If you write on the 1st form 40 what happened and why it failed, I need a copy of that Form 40. Also, note: Technically, form 39 states you should notify a Department inspector when an inspection fails (even if you know the cause.) To satisfy that requirement, you simply have to send an email that says, "Yeah, it failed. I know why, (example: User error), and will reinspect."
