On August 20, 2018 two separate inspections were completed on LPD's Intoxilyzers. Due to a cracked simulator jar, Intoxilyzer 80-005810 and 80-001057 had low readings for the .08 alcohol reference solution (1st Inspection). The glass simulator jar was replaced and with approval from Mrs. Danielle Bell (FDLE), All four Intoxilyzers were re-inspected and passed inspection (2nd Inspection).
