During a routine data audit, I noticed instrument 80-000206 (outside my assigned region) had multiple incomplete Agency Inspections that were erroneously marked as compliant. I tried reaching out to the Agency Inspector, Mary Bowermaster, multiple times over four months (October 2020 to February 2021). None of my calls or emails were returned. Her voicemail indicated that email was the best method of communication, and she used that email address to contact me on 12/17/2020 about coordinating last-minute Department Inspections on another instrument, so I knew it was an active/valid email. After discussing with Quality Manager Shayla Platt on 2/23/2021, it was decided that one last attempt at contact would be made before ceasing communication efforts.
