Hello,

It looks like instrument 1007 had multiple breath tests run on it during the month of July without an Agency Inspection. The instrument's June inspection was uploaded in early July, but from what I can see, there's no July Agency Inspection. Can one of you please confirm this?

If the July inspection was missed, I would need you to do the following:

- Fill out the blank Form 40 I've attached describing why the inspection did not occur, then return it to me
- Distribute the attached list of affected breath tests to your local State Attorney's Office
- Inform your local State Attorney's Office that these breath tests were run on an instrument that was not compliant with 11D-8 and refer them to me if they have any questions.
