CMI, Inc. advised that repairs should be complete in the next 4-6 weeks. The delay on this repair was due to new breath hoses being out of stock at CMI, Inc.

Going forward, at least for the next few months, I would suggest inspecting one instrument at a time. It may be that due to their proximity, the sample passing through the exhaust of one may be getting picked up by the other. If you continue to detect Interferents even with this precaution and it's not related to a cologne or fragrance, please let me know and we will discuss a new plan of action. In addition, you can send the instrument to me as soon as January rolls around and I will inspect it to see if I can duplicate what you are seeing.
