Florida Administrative Code Rules for Rule Chapter 11B-27, F.A.C.,

Effective between September 14 and 17, 2017

Pursuant to Technical Memorandum 2017-08, effective July 19, 2017, numerous changes were made to the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) Rule Chapters promulgated by the Commission. As a result of correspondence received from the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC), Rule Chapter 11B-27, F.A.C., was temporarily removed from the 2016-2017 Proposed Rule Packet and a Notice of Change filed with the Bureau of Administrative Code (BAC).

The effective date for the proposed revisions to Rule Chapter 11B-27, F.A.C., will be between September 14 and 17, 2017. Please be advised that this effective date only applies to the revised rule text and <u>will not</u> prevent the usage of newly revised forms incorporated by reference in multiple rules. The newly revised CJSTC forms were promulgated in the 2016-2017 Proposed Rule Packet, effective July 2017.

The significant 2016-2017 proposed rule changes to Rule Chapter 11B-27, F.A.C., are as follows:

# 11B-27.002 Certification and Employment or Appointment: Certification, Employment or Appointment, Reactivation, and Terminating Employment or Appointment of Officers.

11B-27.002(1)(d) This revision combines the original Physician's Assessment, form CJSTC-75, and the Physical Fitness Assessment, form CJSTC-75B, to create and incorporate the revised Physician's Assessment, form CJSTC-75, which includes the student participation activities and medical conditions regarding OC/CS contamination; and prohibits a chiropractor from completing the form as a medical doctor. The original form CJSTC-75B will be repealed.

11B-27.002(3)(a)11. This revision updates the Exemption-From-Training, form CJSTC-76, to change the discipline field name to "Florida Correctional Probation Officer Training Academy" and revise the comparable training topics.

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11B-27.002(3)(a)15. This revision updates the Affidavit of Separation, form CJSTC-61, and removes the reference to the Affidavit of Separation Supplement, form CJSTC-61A, which is being repealed. It also provides clarification concerning an agency's responsibility in conducting an internal investigation upon the separation of an officer.

11B-27.002(6) This revision deletes the paragraph containing the repealed Affidavit of Separation Supplement, form CJSTC-61A, because the form will no longer be used.

#### 11B-27.00211 Fingerprint Processing and Criminal Record Results.

11B-27.00211(2)(a) This revision updates the forms website link.

# 11B-27.003 Certification and Employment or Appointment: Duty to Report, Investigations, Procedures.

11B-27.003(2)(a) This revision updates the Internal Investigation Report, form CJSTC-78, to update the instructions for completing the form; specifies that only the last four digits of the officer's social security number are required for completion of the form, pursuant to 119.071, F.S.; and updates the forms website link.
