Updates to CMS First Aid Instructor Course, number 1114

During the November 2017 Commission meeting, the Commission adopted revisions to the CMS First Aid Instructor Course, number 1114, with an effective date of November 9, 2017.

First Aid instructors will no longer be required to complete CPR instructor training prior to taking this course. In addition, instructor students will no longer be required to use the textbook that corresponds to their CPR instructor's affiliated association.

To reflect these updates, the following changes have been made in the front material of the course:

- Under Academy Guidelines, the sentence requiring completion of CPR instructor training before taking the course has been removed.
- Language specifying which CPR textbook must be used in the course has been removed.
- An updated web link directing users to the CJSTC forms has been provided.
- The copyright date has been updated.

These revisions only reflect changes to the course's front material. There are no revisions to the course hours or curriculum content.
