New Advanced Training Program Course #1171 Child Sex Crimes Investigations

In September 2016, Advanced Course #033 Sex Crimes Investigations was retired. Two (2) separate courses, Adult Sex Crimes Investigations and Child Sex Crimes Investigations, were developed to replace the retired course in the Advanced Training Program. During the May 2017 meeting, the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission approved the new Advanced Course #1171 Child Sex Crimes Investigations, effective May 11, 2017.

This new 40-hour course reflects a more task-oriented approach to child sexual abuse investigations. It outlines procedures for effectively investigating these cases while focusing on the child's well-being.
