SUBJECT: Approval of Advanced Course, #1423, Economic Crime Investigations

In August 2021, the Training Center Director's Association voted for Commission staff to develop a new course on economic crime investigations to replace the retired Advanced Course, #1154, Financial Fraud Investigations.

Commission staff worked with subject matter experts and practitioners to develop training that provides more information on the types of economic crimes an investigator will likely encounter, along with classroom activities, electives, and scenarios.

On August 10, 2023, the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission approved the new 40-hour Advanced Course, #1423, Economic Crime Investigations. Those who have completed Advanced Course, #1154, Financial Fraud Investigations are eligible to receive salary incentive or mandatory retraining credit for completing the new course.
