#### **PURPOSE**

- Occupy a position which influences agency policy, or impacts operations of the organization;
- Provide an employment history of progressing supervisory, management, and leadership responsibilities;
- Currently holds the rank or position of supervising *mid-level* management;
- Have the intent to remain in criminal justice for at least five years following completion of the seminar:
- Have written endorsement of the agency chief executive.
