An Evaluation of The Florida Criminal Justice Executive Institute Senior Leadership Program

This is the report of a level three, macro-evaluation, of the first three sessions of a senior management level criminal justice training program which is conducted by the Florida Criminal Justice Executive Institute. It was done to determine if the program is attaining its stated goals and providing the intended service to the graduates and the agencies that send them to the program. The necessary data were collected using questionnaires of all enrollees and supervisors who had observed the workplace behaviors of each graduate before and after completion of the program. This study found that the program is generally meeting its goals, and does in the opinion of those who observe the post graduation improvement in work behavior of the program's graduates, provide a useful service. A number of weaknesses were discovered, and recommendations for improvement are made.
