The Florida Criminal Justice Executive Institute (FCJEI) is excited to announce that it is currently taking applications for the next Executive Leadership Seminar (ELS) scheduled for the summer of 2024. ELS is a unique educational opportunity for upper management leadership within Florida Criminal Justice organizations. This program is delivered in three sessions, each emphasizing a different aspect of leadership. Topics will include communicating through a crisis, thinking critically, leading people, managing organizations, overcoming adversity, emotional intelligence and servant leadership.

We are currently accepting applications for Class 11, which will be delivered on the following dates in <u>Tampa</u>, <u>FL</u>.

Session 1 June 3-7, 2024

Session 2 July 15 – 19, 2024

<u>Session 3</u> August 19 – 23, 2024

To qualify for acceptance into ELS, applicants must:

- ✓ Occupy a criminal justice management position which includes full-time, permanent supervision of others (see 4th bullet below for related details);
- Occupy a position which influences agency policy, or impacts operations of the organization;
- ✓ Provide an employment history of progressing supervisory, management, and leadership responsibilities;
- ✓ Currently hold the rank or position of supervising mid-level management personnel; two levels of management subordinate to current position/rank (i.e. Major, Captain, Director, etc.);
- ✓ Have the intent to remain in criminal justice for at least five years following completion of the seminar;
- ✓ Have the written endorsement of the agency chief executive.
