<list-item><list-item><list-item><list-item></list-item></list-item></list-item></list-item>	<ul> <li>✓ Report suspicious activity to law enforcement describing specifically what you saw, where it occurred and why it's suspicious.</li> <li>✓ Make note of suspicious statements, people and/or vehicles.</li> <li>✓ Report threats made verbally or on social media.</li> <li>✓ If you are a business owner, ensure property is well-lit; fire alarms and emergency communications equipment is operational.</li> <li>✓ Train employees about what is suspicious.</li> <li>✓ Make visitors aware by posting "If You See Something, Say Something™" signs or stickers.</li> <li>✓ If something seems wrong, notify law enforcement authorities.</li> <li><i>It is important to remember that just because someone's speech, actions, beliefs, appearance, or way of life are different, it does not mean that he or she is suspicious.</i></li> <li>Do not jeopardize your safety or the safety of others. In an emergency, call 911.</li> <li>Preventing terrorism is a community effort.
