

## Potential Indicators of Suspicious Activities Related To Amusement Parks

### What Should I Consider Suspicious?

- Attempt to survey security locations/procedures (take pictures, use binoculars, draw diagrams, etc.)
- Ask unusual questions regarding key facilities, security procedures, 'profile' of patrons, etc.
- Attempt to bring in dangerous chemicals, explosives, weapons, ammunition, unusual packages, containers, etc.
- Deliberately attempt to access restricted areas
- Dress in unseasonably bulky clothing
- Attempt any aforementioned action while avoiding eye contact or otherwise acting nervous, jittery, uneasy, or vague
- Suspicious attempts to acquire official vehicles, uniforms, badges, access cards, etc.
- Suspicious/unattended vehicles, particularly those parked adjacent to the establishment
- Unattended packages/bags or suspicious packages received by mail
- Behavior which appears to denote planning for terrorist activity (mapping out routes, playing out scenarios, monitoring key facilities, etc.)
- Overheard unusual or alarming statements
- Damage to security devices (cameras, fencing, etc.)
- A pattern of false alarms requiring law enforcement response

### What Should I Do?

- ✓ Make note of suspicious statements, activities, people, and/or vehicles
- ✓ Report threats (whether verbal, written, or electronic) against an individual or facility
- ✓ Report suspicious unattended bags and packages
- ✓ Report visible damage to security devices

*It is important to remember that just because someone's speech, actions, beliefs, appearance, or way of life are different, it does not mean that he or she is suspicious.*

### What Should I Do? (Cont'd)

**Parks can ensure the safety of patrons and staff by having security training and protocols.**

- ✓ Designate a security manager to establish training programs and security procedures for employees
- ✓ Establish a threat alert system
- ✓ Know the delivery vehicles and staff who are routinely on the property
- ✓ Install security cameras
- ✓ Ensure fire alarms and equipment are operational
- ✓ Work with law enforcement to identify additional appropriate security procedures

**Do not jeopardize your safety or the safety of others. In an emergency, call 911.**
